2022 GRAND MARSHAL: Jim Swant, USAF (Ret.)

All parade entrants are asked to observe the guidelines and supply information where requested to assist the Veterans Day Parade Committee in proper planning of the event. These guidelines are for the safety and concerns of all involved.

- 1. All entries should have a Veterans or patriotic theme, greeting and/or flags, as awards will be given for multiple categories!
- 2. During the parade, please keep a distance of 50' or more between entries. All Parade participants must comply with current traffic laws and regulations.
- 3. Signs identifying the veterans who are participating and/or being honored are encouraged! If you wish to order magnetic car signs from VistaPrint (approx. \$15), please contact Veterans Parade Committee (541) 517-5333, or the TR Hunter Office, below.
- 4. Animal entries must provide their own street cleanup behind the entry
- 5. The Veterans Parade Committee of Florence policy *strictly prohibits throwing* candy, prizes, novelty items and any other items from any unit . . . **but they can be handed out!**
- 6. Absolutely NO alcoholic beverages or consumption of alcohol is permitted in the Parade. Any participant judged to be in possession, or under the influence, of alcohol or any other substance, shall be asked to leave and subject to removal.
