## **Camelot Carriage Rides**

In business since 1997, Camelot Carriage Rides is a family-owned and family-run business. Camelot's horses are Draft horses- White Percheron and Black Clydesdale, and the carriages are white Vis-a-Vis, which can be open or fully enclosed. You can also choose a full-size wagon for large groups.

Details: Rides begin and end at Don Hall's Gas House & Takaoka downtown, although special locations can be negotiated.

## **Rosewood Carriage Rides**

In business since 2003, Rosewood is based in Huntertown, but serves Fort Wayne and the surrounding areas. A majestic Percheron Draft horse pulls each carriage so you can sit back and enjoy the leisurely pace of a horse-drawn carriage ride.

Details: Rides begin and end at Don Hall's Gas House & Takaoka downtown, although special locations can be negotiated. To tour downtown Fort Wayne, \$35 gets you half an hour, and \$70 one hour.

## **Sentimental Journey Carriage Rides**

Like Camelot and Rosewood, Sentimental Journey has both carriages for a more intimate ride and larger wagons for big groups. Sentimental Journey began in 1993 and offers three elegant white carriages and four beautiful horses to make your occasion spectacular.

Details: Rides begin and end at Don Hall's Gas House & Takaoka downtown, although special locations can be negotiated. \$35 gets you half an hour, and \$70 one hour for tours of downtown Fort Wayne. Most days, 24-hour notice is all you need to book your ride!
