The Broadway Corridor

The Electric Works campus is located on downtown's **Broadway Corridor**, just a few blocks from Parkview Field. The Broadway Corridor is home to an eclectic mix of shops, nightlife, murals and dining options that make the journey part of the fun!



Farmers Markets

The Fort Wayne Farmer's Market is set up in Electric Works' **Dynamo Alley** every Saturday in the summer from 9 am–1 pm and on Wednesdays from 4-7 pm. For other special events, check out their Events Calendar at **unionstreetmarket.org/events.**



Visitors to Electric Works have several other parking options, including:

- **The Union Parking Garage** has approximately 300 spaces where visitors to Electric Works can park for free. After two hours an hourly fee will apply. Enter the garage from Broadway, just north of the railroad bridge.
- Swinney Avenue Lot Visitor Lot adjacent to AMP Lab High School on Swinney Avenue between Broadway and College.
- **Public Lot** Parking lot on the east side of McCulloch Park. Enter Lindley Avenue from Taylor Street or Parkview Avenue from Broadway.
- Wall Street Lot West Parking Lots on Wall Street, west of College Street.
