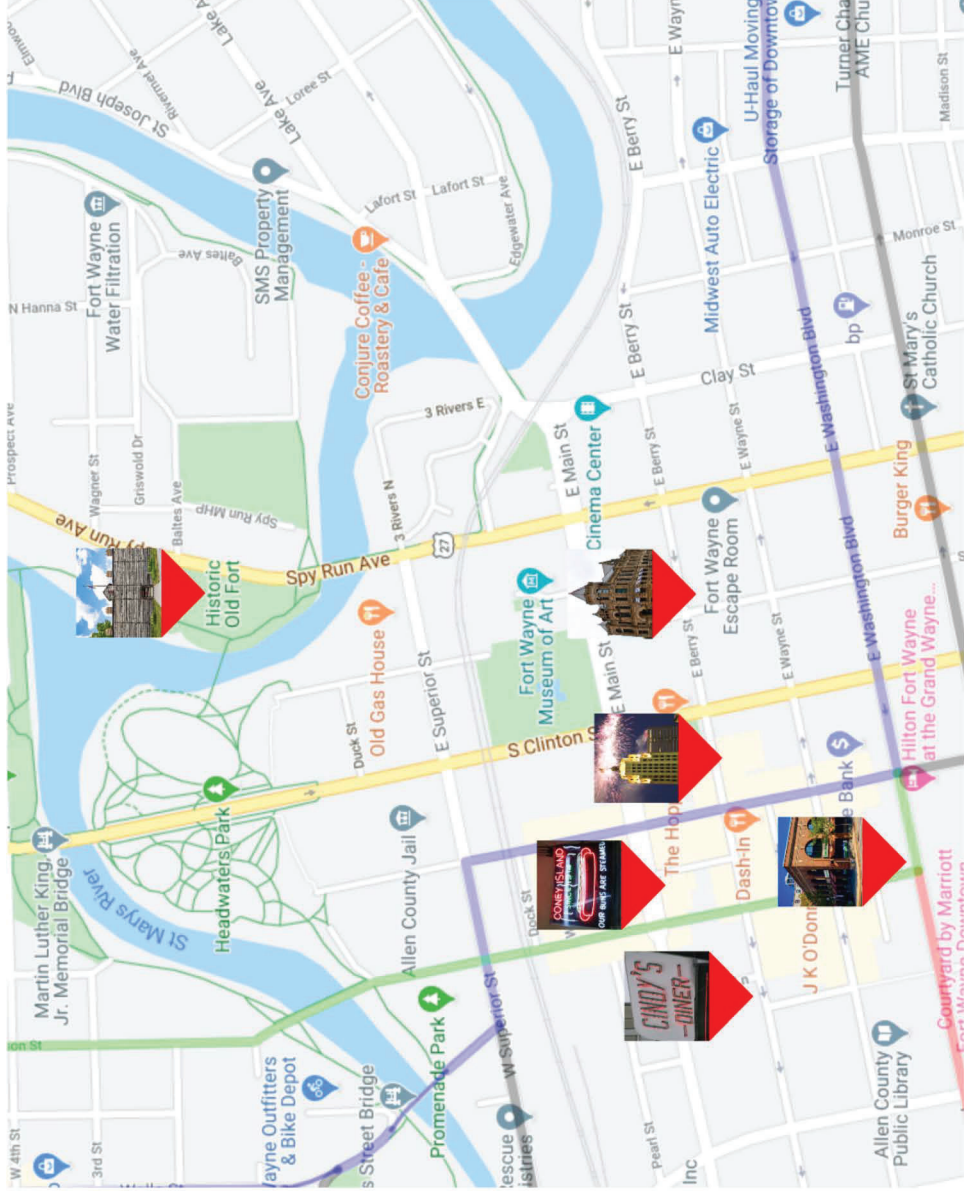


# Travel the Lincoln Highway through Fort Wayne, Indiana!
