The romance and mystique of 19th century cattle drives lives on in the **Fort Worth Herd**, the world’s only twice-daily, historically true cattle drive. A top attraction in Texas, the Fort Worth Herd has engaged more than a quarter-million students through tour groups and education programs. Authentic Texas cowboys and cowgirls drive Texas longhorns down **Exchange Street** every day at **11:30am and 4pm**.

1883 LOCATIONS TOUR
Taylor Sheridan’s TV series on Paramount+, **1883**, tells the Dutton family origin story and serves as a prequel to the television show **Yellowstone**. The show features a star-studded cast including Sam Elliott, Tim McGraw, Faith Hill and Billy Bob Thornton. The first two episodes of the series were filmed in the **Fort Worth Stockyards** and surrounding areas with the help of the **Fort Worth Film Commission**.

The production completely transformed the west blocks of Exchange Avenue to create Hell’s Half Acre, adding dirt roads covering multiple blocks and removal of street signs and creation of custom facades to transport the buildings back to 1883. DICKIES ARENA

The multipurpose arena is located at the **Will Rogers Memorial Center Complex** in the Cultural District, 10 minutes from downtown. The versatile 14,000-seat arena is home to the annual **Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo** and can transform into a **concert venue**, hosting legends like George Strait and ZZ Top, a **sporting complex** for events such as NCAA gymnastics championships and WTA Tennis, or a **meeting space** for conferences and conventions.

KIMBELL ART MUSEUM

The Kimbell’s permanent collection ranges from the the **third millennium B.C. to the mid-20th century**, and includes major works by Fra Angelico, Velazquez, Bernini, Rembrandt, Goya, Monet, Cezanne, Picasso, Mondrian and Matisse. It is also home to Michelangelo’s first known painting. The collection comprises Asian and non-Western as well as European art. The museum features special and traveling exhibits on display throughout the year. Designed by world-renowned architect **Louis Kahn**, the museum is often referred to as one of the **most significant works of architecture of the 20th century**. The Kimbell Art Museum is celebrating its 50th anniversary through October 2023. The gift shop has exhibition merchandise, art prints and posters, books, gifts, and children’s book and games.

THE CRESCENT HOTEL

The Crescent Hotel, scheduled to open in summer 2023, will feature **200 luxury rooms**, a restaurant, a rooftop lounge, and 8,000 square feet of ballroom/meeting space. The hotel will also include a landscaped courtyard capable of hosting outdoor dining, events, and social activities. The hotel is a part of a \$250 million mixed-use development in the Fort Worth Cultural District.



SHOPPING

Tanger Outlets offers 70 brand-name and designer outlet stores in North Fort Worth just **minutes from Texas Motor Speedway**. **The Shops at Clearfork** is a 500,000-square-foot open-air shopping, dining and entertainment development anchored by luxury retailer Neiman Marcus. **Sundance Square** is where cosmopolitan sophistication meets Western hospitality with 35-blocks of shopping, nightlife, hotels and restaurants downtown.

AIRPORT TO DOWNTOWN

TEXRAIL

TEXRail is the new 27-mile commuter rail line connecting DFW International Airport and downtown Fort Worth. The line runs every day and saves travelers **21 minutes** at the affordable rate of **\$2.50 each way**.



JUNETEENTH MUSEUM

After decades of work advocating to make Juneteenth a federal holiday, **Fort Worthian Opal Lee** recently realized her life’s dream when the day commemorating the emancipation of enslaved African Americans became a national day of remembrance. Building on that legacy is the **National Juneteenth Museum**, set to open in 2025 on the Southside. The \$70 million museum will feature works that highlight the institution of slavery and historic moments that led to its abolishment. Part of the mission of the museum will be to revitalize the underserved, largely Black community that lives in the 76104 ZIP code.

TANNAHILL’S TAVERN & MUSIC HALL

Some of the **biggest music acts in the country** perform at newcomer Tannahill’s Tavern & Music Hall. The large venue features a cocktail lounge, pizza shop and an elegant restaurant famed for its crab fritters and grilled oysters. The venue is the lifelong dream of **Chef Tim Love**, whose love of live shows inspired him to open a venue where the menu is as compelling as the live performances.

WHISKEY RANCH

Whiskey Ranch, the **largest whiskey distillery west of the Mississippi** is home to **Firestone & Robertson’s award-winning TX Whiskey and TX Straight Bourbon**. Located on the historic golf course where legends **Ben Hogan and Byron Nelson** once played, its beautiful views of downtown make it perfect for offsite meetings and events. Whiskey Ranch offers a merchandise store, tours, bar and tasting room, and back porch with outdoor fireplaces overlooking the golf course. STOCKYARDS HERITAGE DEVELOPMENT

Stockyards Heritage Development Co.’s renovation of **historic Mule Alley** in the Fort Worth Stockyards includes shops, eateries, creative workplaces and live-entertainment venues. It is anchored by the **Hotel Drover, a Marriott Autograph Collection resort**, and artfully celebrates the legendary cowboys who drove cattle across the plains to market in Fort Worth. The Hotel Drover has been ranked **the best hotel in DFW** by *Travel & Leisure*.

PREDATORS OF ASIA & AFRICA

The third phase of Fort Worth’s Zoo’s campaign, **A Wilder Vision**, features cascading waterfalls, multiple pools and lush habitats for apex predators from Africa and Asia. The new space allows for enriched environments and better spectator views of **striped hyenas, critically endangered Malayan tigers, clouded leopards and more**.
