Distilleries and craft breweries are taking Fort Worth by storm. Sample the local flavors at a public tasting or ask the barkeep what's on tap; you'll enjoy it to the last drop.

Firestone & Robertson Distilling Company

As the only artisanal bourbon distillery in North Texas, Firestone & Robertson Distilling Co. has created two distinct whiskey brands: one a straight bourbon whiskey and the other a premium blended whiskey, TX Whiskey. Wildly popular throughout the state and Louisiana, the distillery offers group tours and tastings on select Saturdays for a maximum of 40 guests. Admission is \$16.25 per person.

The only vodka on the market made from black-eyed peas, **TreyMark Black-Eyed Vodka** is distilled in Fort Worth's up-and-coming Near Southside district. The distillery became fully operational in July 2014 and makes up to 3,400 bottles a week at \$35 per bottle. Tours and tastings are not offered at this time.

Founded in 2004, Rahr & Sons Brewing Co. is a Fort Worth-favorite when it comes to craft beer. Situated in the Near Southside district, patrons are invited to kick back every Wednesday from 5-7:30 p.m. and Saturday from 1-3 p.m. during the public tours and tastings. Live music and local food trucks complete the experience. Entry is \$10 for guests 18 years and older.

Panther Island Brewing

As Panther Island's newest addition, Panther Island Brewing is the exclusive beer vendor of Panther Island Pavilion's family-friendly event, Sunday Funday. Located off the banks of the Trinity River near Coyote Drive-In, the microbrewery produces four kegs: **Allergeez**, **Boom**, **Cannonball** and **IPf'nA**. The brewery will be open for public tours and tastings in the coming months.
