


Community and Marketing Efforts

 - The Fort Worth Sports Commission will act as the local host organization.
 We will set up a planning committee of community leaders to supplement our staff to meet all the needs of the CrossFit Games.

- Provide information on the local ambulance service and area hospitals
 - MedStar is the local provider for ambulance services in the Fort Worth area. Currently rates are \$60 per hour for an ambulance and two EMT's
 - Fort Worth's Medical District is less than a 10-minute drive from all venues. Hospitals include:

 - Work with CrossFit Games to create custom content to promote the event, including but not limited to blogs, itineraries, custom graphics and video content.
 - Provide CrossFit Games with an ad performance recap report post campaign.

- The local organizing committee will work with Fort Worth Emergency Operations Center (EOC) for citywide emergency planning for the event. The EOC builds the safety plan to fit each event. We will work closely with the City to put together a plan that fits the diverse needs of CrossFit Games.
