

Will Rogers Memorial Center

Established in Fort Worth, Texas in 1936 to house events near downtown and in the Cultural District, the Will Rogers Memorial Center now attracts in excess of 2.5 million visitors each year. This 125-acre facility plays host to an extensive variety of social, cultural, educational, recreational and sporting events. The heart of the facility is the historic Will Rogers Coliseum which is home for many equestrian and sporting events including the legendary Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo which celebrated its 123rd championship year in 2020.

Over 3,800 hotel rooms are accessible within three miles of the Center for the convenience of your staff, referees and exhibitors. The Will Rogers Memorial Center also offers a unique location set in one of the country's most heralded cultural districts including the Kimbell Art Museum, Modern Art Museum of Fort Worth, Amon Carter Museum of American Art, Fort Worth Museum of Science & History, National Cowgirl Museum and Hall of Fame and the 109-acre Fort Worth Botanic Garden.

The Round Up Inn Room (located in our Amon G. Carter, Jr. Exhibits Hall) offers 18,000 square feet of climate controlled floor space. It also has a built in stage, dressing rooms, and a bar built into the room itself.

980 square feet The Silver Spur Room (located in our Amon G. Carter, Jr. Exhibits Hall) offers 980 square feet of climate controlled floor space.

South Texas Room

Your organization will also be responsible for all expenses invoiced directly to you by our exclusive service providers. This will include all internet and telecommunications needs, electrical needs, event staffing (ushers and security), decorators and all city taxes owed.

To assist with your planning, here is some additional information about our services and capabilities:

Audio Visual Equipment:

Will Rogers Memorial Center will supply existing lighting and house sound with the building rental. You are welcome to use your own A/V Company and the power drop would be ordered directly through our exclusive electrical provider.

Catering/Concessions:

The City of Fort Worth currently has an open catering policy. You will have the ability to select one of our approved caterers to provide services for any meal function you may have and they are required to pay a twenty-two percent (22%) catering commission on the total charges to the City of Fort Worth. The Will Rogers Memorial Center concessions services provider retains the exclusive rights regarding the service and sale of any alcoholic beverages and concession services. They would be open daily for your event and have the capability for you to purchase meal vouchers from.

Parking:

Paid parking is available in adjacent surface lots and garages. The current special event rate is \$10 per day anywhere on the main campus and this rate is subject to change. You will receive a minimum of ten complimentary parking passes with your contract.

Electricity/Climate Control:

Edlen Electrical Exhibition Services is the WRMC exclusive provider for electrical distribution. All electrical requirements for the competition space, commercial vendors and/or above and beyond that which is readily available must be contracted through the city's exclusive provider. Air conditioning and/or heating are included with the venue rental.

Insurance:

Your show will be required to furnish a General Liability Insurance Policy/Certificate of Insurance showing coverage of at least \$1,000,000 Combined Single Limit per occurrence (or reasonable equivalent split limits) during the period of time stipulated on your Rental Agreement. This coverage must show the City of Fort Worth as additional insured.

Internet/Wi-Fi:

NetSteady Communications is our exclusive internet, video and telecom services provider. They have extensive experience and specialize in multi-use facilities like ours and understand the diverse needs of our wide variety of event types.

Security/Crowd Management:

Lone Star Security and Usher & More are our exclusive provider for crowd management staffing to include security, ushers and door guards when required. Off-duty Fort Worth Police officers are also available to schedule should you need them for your event as well. The final staffing requirements will be determined based on your anticipated attendance and schedule. These service providers will bill you directly for the staffing scheduled.

Ticketing:

We do not have an exclusive or in-house ticketing agency, so you are welcome to use your preferred ticket agency and on-site box office staff. (Ticketmaster and Prekindle are most commonly used.) The City of Fort Worth does have a 10% admission tax (for paid admissions only) that would be billed directly to you by the City of Fort Worth and is based on the admission charged.

Rental Price:

WILL ROGERS MEMORIAL CENTER

The Cattle Barn and Small Exhibits building is indoor, but not climate controlled. The Promenade is a covered outdoor area, not climate controlled.

• What capabilities does it have for video boards, ribbon boards, or other electronic signage? What are the audio capabilities in the location?

All of our facilities have built in audio system capabilities. They can be configured to be individualized for each space, or one connected system across all facilities. We do have the capability of outside video boards being brought in.

• What is the available upload and download internet bandwidth at each location? Please provide information on reliability and redundancy, as appropriate.

We work with a company called NetSteady, who is our exclusive internet provider. Please see attached rate sheet for their capabilities and pricing.

We have both outdoor parking lots available, as well as an underground parking garage located under the Amon G. Carter, Jr. Exhibits Hall. Overall we have over 6000 regular parking spots available and parking for 212 Recreational Vehicles.

• What facilities exist at each location, including locker rooms, shower facilities, spectator restrooms, administrative offices, box office, back-of-house storage space, loading docks, etc.? Please provide details on each.

All indoor facilities have their own dedicated bathrooms for spectators. We do have offices available in the Cattle Barn, Small Exhibits Building, and Amon G. Carter, Jr. Exhibits Hall. Loading docks are available on the North side of the Exhibits Hall.








DIDYOUKNOW?

The Will Rogers Memorial Center was named for Will Rogers, well-known American Humorist, who was born in 1879 and died in an airplane crash in 1935. The late Will Rogers was very close friends with Amon G. Carter, who will always be remembered as a dynamic business leader in Fort Worth and was instrumental in completion of the facility in 1936 to coincide with the Texas Centennial celebration. The Will Rogers Auditorium, Will Rogers Coliseum and Pioneer Tower are the remaining original buildings and are included on the National Register of Historic Places. Some notable events in our history include the Trapp Family Singers, Billy Graham Revival, The Rolling Stones, Placido Domingo, Aretha Franklin, Jimi Hendrix, Gene Autry Ali vs. Frazier, and many more.

FACILITY IMPROVEMENT

The City of Fort Worth recognizes the importance to maintain and improve the Will Rogers Memorial Center as necessary to compete on a national and international level. Since 2010, over \$95 million in renovations and facility improvements have been completed and include the following projects. More projects are in the works!

• Western Heritage Garage: A new 1,100 space parking garage was completed in 2010 on the west side of the campus to better accommodate the growing parking impact of the facility.

• Equestrian Multi-Purpose Building: A new two-level building was completed in 2012 and accommodates 1,000 parking spaces or 745 stalls and 15 wash bays on the lower level and two 100'x200' indoor arenas on the upper level. The lower level also has access to the underground tunnel system.

• The Pavilion: A new pavilion was completed in 2014 and accommodates a covered 128'x250' arena with covered access to the Richardson-Bass Building/John Justin Arena and the underground tunnel system.

• Barns 1 and 2: In 2015, a \$15 million renovation of Barn 2 and the Show Arena and construction of the new Tower Promenade were completed. The extensive renovation brought modern amenities and comfort to the 1940's barns and continued with completion of Barn 1 and the Small Exhibits Building in 2018.

• **LED Lighting:** All original lighting has been replaced in the performance arenas, main barns and many additional locations with new LED fixtures and lighting. This project has greatly improved light quality, increased energy efficiency and reduced radiant heat from the fixtures.

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Established in Fort Worth, Texas in 1936 to house events near downtown and in the Cultural District, the Will Rogers Memorial Center now attracts in excess of 2.4 million visitors each year. This 125-acre facility plays host to an extensive variety of cultural, corporate, educational, recreational and sporting events including many annual national and international equestrian and livestock shows.

The heart of the facility is the historic Will Rogers Coliseum, the first domed structure of its' type built in 1936, with 5,652 permanent seats and a 125' x 250' arena floor and is connected to the Burnett Building including metal horse stalls, cattle pens, offices and a warm-up area. The Coliseum has been host to many concerts, equestrian shows and sporting events including the legendary Fort Worth Stock Show & Rodeo since 1944. Located above the Coliseum lobby, the Backstage Club offers a truly unique setting for a social or meal event with w estern décor, a birds-eye view of the Coliseum arena and the award-winning cuisine of Reata Restaurant.

Also built in 1936 to celebrate Texas' centennial celebration, the Will Rogers Auditorium features 2,856 permanent seats, a proscenium stage, extensive dressing room capacity and beautiful Art Deco features inside and out. For almost 80 years, the theater has been host to national musical, comedic and dance performances, Broadway touring productions as well as local performing arts and educational events. Additionally, the venue offers a great alternative for corporate meetings and seminars.

Opening in 1984, the Amon G. Carter Jr. Exhibits Hall includes the Texas Room with over 94,000 square feet of contiguous exhibit space, the 18,000 square foot Round Up Inn ballroom and four additional meeting rooms. The building is host to a variety of events from black tie galas to conventions to western & horse themed trade shows and sometimes simultaneously...a chance to experience the Cowboys and Culture theme of Fort Worth under one roof!

Catering to the international equestrian world, the Will Rogers Equestrian Center continues to be the venue of choice for many of the top equestrian breed and discipline competitions and livestock shows and features three climate controlled arenas over 2,500 horse stalls and multiple exercise areas.
