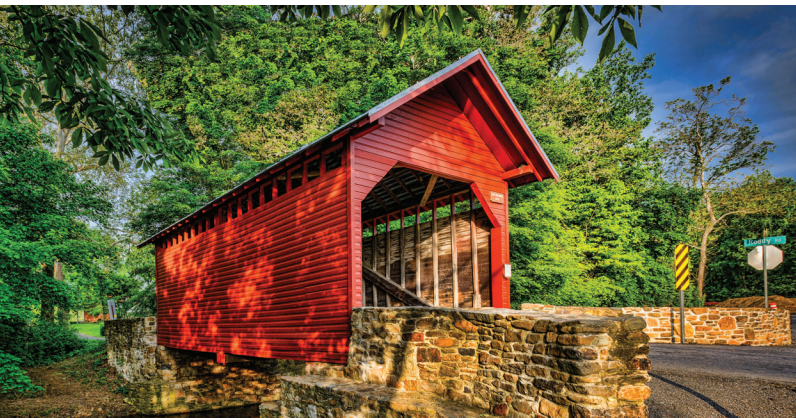


History
