WALK THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF CARROLL CREEK PARK

Created as a flood control project, this picturesque body of water is lined with colorful lilies in the summer and illuminated boats in the winter. The mile and a half long stretch includes pedestrian paths, water features, an amphitheater, and stunning public art. Start in Baker Park and end up near the Frederick Fairgrounds to ensure you don't miss anything!



CLIMB CHIMNEY ROCK

You haven't truly seen Frederick until you've looked down on its tallest trees. The hike is somewhat strenuous, but the view from 1,419 feet over Catoctin Mountain Park is worth every step.



DANCE IN FRONT OF HUNDREDS OF STRANGERS

Friends and families gather at the Baker Park Bandshell every Sunday for the Summer Concert Series. Bands play everything from Beatles music to reggae. Put on your dancing shoes and let the music move you to the front of the crowd.






DINE AT VOLT'S FAMOUS TABLE 21


SINCE ITS FOUNDING IN 1748,

and the founding of the City of Frederick just three years earlier, Frederick County has played a role in every chapter of the American story. Picturesque historic buildings, one-of-a-kind museums, and engaging walking tours throughout Frederick County bring centuries of history to life.



SPIRITUAL JOURNEYS

Our rich religious heritage is evident at Emmitsburg's National Shrine of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, which tells the story of the first American-born saint. 2020 is the Year of the Woman, and there is no better time to reflect on this important historical figure. Nearby, at Mount St. Mary's University, is the National Shrine Grotto of Lourdes, which features one of the oldest American replicas of France's Lourdes Shrine.




HISTORIC

Eighteenth-century
structures dot the county,
like the Schifferstadt
Architectural Museum
in Frederick, which is a
fine example of an early
German colonial home. The
Catoctin Furnace, in the
nearby town of Thurmont,
is a 1770s industrial site at
Cunningham Falls State
Park. The iron furnace, and
the adjacent company village,
have played important roles

in the nation's history.

TRANSPORTATION HERITAGE

Frederick County stands at the crossroads of two National Scenic Byways. The **Historic National Road**, "The Road That Built The Nation," crosses the county from east to west. The **Journey Through Hallowed Ground** travels along U.S. 15 from north to south.



Early transportation advances are evident throughout Frederick County. The nation's earliest railroad, the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad, and the Chesapeake & Ohio Canal first converge and compete for passage westward through the mountains. Brunswick's Heritage (Railroad) Museum tells the story of both modes of transport and how they alternately shaped the town. Today, hikers and cyclists travel the towpath and cross the aqueducts in the C&O Canal National Historical Park. You can even stay the night in a rustic canal lockkeeper's house.



BETWEEN NORTH & SOUTH

At the heart of America's Civil War, Frederick County's location between the Potomac River and the Mason-Dixon Line meant it was alternately occupied by troops from both sides and the site of important battles.

Confederate General Robert E.
Lee's first invasion of the "North"
in September 1862 led to the
battles of South Mountain and
Antietam. At South Mountain State
Battlefield, learn how Lee held back
Union General. George McClellan's
army and regrouped his own
forces at nearby Sharpsburg,
where the Battle of Antietam
was fought three days later.

Civil War Trail markers tell how in June 1863, the Union Army of the Potomac strategized here in the days before the nearby Battle of Gettysburg.

THE "BATTLE THAT SAVED WASHINGTON"

At Monocacy National Battlefield, find out about the July 1864 "Battle That Saved Washington," part of the final Confederate effort to move the war north.

Although Union General Lew Wallace's 5,800 Union soldiers were defeated by General Jubal Early's 18,000 troops, the encounter afforded enough time to militarily reinforce the nation's capital.

ONE VAST HOSPITAL

Immediately following the nearby battles, Frederick was transformed into "one vast hospital", with churches and large buildings used as makeshift infirmaries, where thousands of soldiers were treated. The story of the city's compassion and great medical progress is depicted at the National Museum of Civil War Medicine in Downtown Frederick.

BRUNSWICK HERITAGE (RAILROAD) MUSEUM Interactive HO-scale model railroad depicting
