

## ATTRACTIONS OPEN ON EASTER SUNDAY 2022

**Enchanted Rock State Natural Area:** RR 965 North (18 miles). (830) 685-3636. This 1,643-acre park is home to the second largest granite outcropping in the US and provides opportunities for hiking, rock climbing, rappelling, camping, and picnicking. **Day pass reservations are required** and can be made online at [texasstateparks.reserveamerica.com/](https://texasstateparks.reserveamerica.com/)

**Lady Bird Johnson Municipal Park:** 3 miles south on State Hwy 16. (830) 997-4202. This 340-acre park features wooded picnic and recreation areas. The Lady Bird Johnson Park has pavilions, playgrounds, tennis courts, a nature trail and fishing. **LBJ State and National Historical Parks:** 199 State Park Road 52 in Stonewall. (830) 644-2252. The LBJ park complex encompasses 700 acres and has a visitor center, historic areas, exhibits, and hiking trails. See buffalo, longhorns, and whitetail deer. Open 8:30 AM – 4:00 PM daily. **Sauer-Beckmann Living History Farm:** LBJ State Park, 16 miles east in Stonewall. (830) 644-2455. A living history farm with costumed interpreters reenacting the tasks of an early 1900s farm family. Open 10 AM – 4:00 PM daily.

**Luckenbach, Texas:** E US Hwy 290 to RR 1376 to 412 Luckenbach Town Loop. (830) 997-3224. Established as a trading post in 1849, Luckenbach consists of a dancehall, general store and bar. **The National Museum of the Pacific War:** 340 E. Main. (830) 997-8600. Dedicated to all those who served in the Pacific Theater of WWII. Admission fee. Reservations are recommended and can be made online at [www.pacificwarmuseum.org/](https://www.pacificwarmuseum.org/) Open 9 AM – 5 PM Wednesday – Monday.

**Wildseed Farms:** 7 miles east on US Hwy 290. (830) 990-1393. Visit the nation's largest working wildflower farm featuring over 200 acres of flowers in commercial production. See colorful flowers from spring through the first frost. Open 9:30 AM – 6 PM daily. **\$5 fee to enter walking trails during peak bloom times for age 5 and up.** [www.wildseedfarms.com/](https://www.wildseedfarms.com/)
