National Museum of the Pacific War: This Smithsonian-Affiliated museum offers several venues for groups: a historic ballroom and mezzanine patio, gazebo & courtyard, Japanese Garden of Peace, a boardroom, Cailloux Education Center, and beautifully restored historic Ruff Haus, with spaces for 25 to 400 quests.



Village-Style Lodging: Fredericksburg is home to several unique lodging options that have individual rooms for attendees to stay at the same location as well as provides space to host meetings, team-building activities, and group meals. The spacious accommodations and sparkling outdoor pools create the perfect setting for unique getaways and gatherings. The property features 103 total rooms (including 10 suites). The adjacent Barons Creek Conference Center can accommodate up to 175 attendees, while the Cypress Room accommodates up to 80 attendees.

Theaters: Fredericksburg Theater Company produces musicals, dramas and comedies throughout the year. The theater also hosts special events and can be rented for meetings and catered receptions for up to 200 guests. Rockbox Theater holds a variety of live music shows and can be used for meetings, seminars, and more. Rockbox can hold over 350 guests.



Large Event Spaces: Fredericksburg is home to a variety of wedding and event venues that boast beautiful indoor and outdoor spaces. These venues work great for large banquets but can also be reimagined for use by groups looking for a unique space to host meetings, retreats, and conferences.

The Hangar Hotel and Albert Hotel (coming 2024): Conference Center offers 50 luxury rooms at an adults-only property, just a few miles from downtown Fredericksburg. The themed hotel is also home to the Officer's Club, a themed bar and piano lounge, the Pacific Showroom, and the Airport Conference Center, which

can accommodate up to 500

guests. Full-service catering

is also available on-site.

For the first time since 2015, a new hotel will open in Fredericksburg. The Albert will be Fredericksburg's first full-service hotel. This boutique hotel will have 107 rooms and multiple dining options. The hotel will have customizable indoor and outdoor spaces to provide a backdrop for intimate gatherings and Texas-

sized events.
