MARKTKPLATZ PLAYGROUND

100 block of W. Austin St. The covered playground has numerous climbing, swings, and balancing apparatus for all those little ones.

LADY BIRD JOHNSON MUNICIAPL PARK

This 340-acre park features wooded picnic and recreation areas and has numerous pavilions, playground, tennis courts, nature, and fishing trails.

CROSS MOUNTAIN PARK

Historic city park located 1 ½ miles from Main St on FM 965 N. This area provides an overview of Fredericksburg, which was discovered in 1847. Nature trail and picnic tables available.

ENCHANTED ROCK STATE NATURAL AREA

This 1,643-acre park provides over 8 miles of hiking and nature trails. Provides rock climbing, camping, and wildlife picnic areas. Day pass reservations required.
