The city of Hollywood in Greater Fort Lauderdale is culturally rich, eclectic and beautiful.

Sometimes, if you stand long enough on Hollywood's famed Beach Broadwalk, it feels like a symphony of languages and melodies from around the globe is melding with the ocean waves. Hollywood Beach provides miles of shoreline with plenty of diverse food, casual shopping and even a concert amphitheater for live music.

Throughout the city, you can experience high-end luxuries — like the St. Somewhere Spa at Margaritaville Hollywood Beach Resort — alongside more active attractions like Extreme Rage Paintball Park or Hollywood Beach Golf Club.

For art lovers, the city is a haven of creativity with a vibrant downtown

scene of galleries, restaurants, boutiques and colorful murals along Hollywood Boulevard and the surrounding streets. Enjoy outdoor live performances and food truck rallies at Young Circle, then relish the nightlife at entertainment hubs like the iconic Guitar Hotel at the Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Hollywood.

When Joseph Young, the visionary founder of Hollywood, came to South Florida from California in 1920, he had grand plans to create a sun-kissed playground that would rival its west coast namesake.

Now, a century later, Florida's Hollywood stands as a magical city, where suburban living coexists with a bustling downtown.

A cultural gem in the city is the arthouse Cinema Paradiso Hollywood, offering movie buffs a delightful array of American independent and international films, alongside productions by local talents. On the third Saturday of every month, from 6 p.m. to 11 p.m., Downtown Hollywood bursts to life with ArtWalk activities, featuring guided tours of the Hollywood murals, curated gallery shows and interactions with local artists.

Home to the Seminole Tribe of Florida's headquarters, Hollywood also boasts the Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Hollywood, a marquee

attraction with gaming, performances, nightlife and more. While tribal amenities remain mostly private, public-facing retail outlets and entertainment venues can be found along State Road 7 near the Hard Rock.

Hollywood also embraces a diverse range of outdoor celebrations. Each November, T.Y. (Topeekeegee Yugnee) Park transforms into a medieval realm for the Camelot Days Medieval Festival, where knights and jesters reign supreme. During the Hollyweird Halloween Block Party, Hollywood Boulevard takes on a spooky ambiance. For classic car enthusiasts, the Dream Car Classics car show offers a nostalgic journey through time.

Perhaps today's Hollywood would have exceeded Joseph Young's wildest fantasies.

HOLLYWOOD'S ART SPACES

Hollywood offers an outstanding arts and culture scene, with two very popular areas — ArtsPark at Young Circle and Hollywood Boulevard — where you can soak in the creative energy or participate hands-on.

HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD

Hollywood Boulevard, home to some of the Hollywood Mural Project's finest creations, brings to life the city's mission of beautifying streets with breathtaking art. Watch one of the new murals go up at the monthly Downtown Hollywood ArtWalk event — a sprawling outdoor art festival hosted on the third Saturday evening of each month. Visitors can enjoy live art being created, go on mural and gallery tours, listen to music on every corner, and shop for local art.

On an average day, locations like End to End Gallery invite you to admire exquisite works. Two blocks off the main strip is the city's Arts and Culture Center, filling the rooms of a historic mansion with a gallery, museum and event space. Take in the sights and sounds of contemporary art and film on display, or join one of the youth, teen or adult programs ranging from drawing to comedy.

YOUNG CIRCLE

The beating heart of downtown Hollywood, Young Circle spans 10 acres of lush green. Families with young adventurers can kick start their exploration at the playground, complete with a fun splash pad. As you leisurely stroll through the park, marvel at the sculptures before making a pit stop at the Visual Arts Pavilion where a gallery awaits showcasing changing free exhibits. There are also interactive activities like glass blowing demonstrations and martial arts.

The massive amphitheater hosts regular music and live performances, and throughout the week, you can enjoy outdoor movie screenings, food trucks, rallies and art days for families or creative spirits. At the ArtsPark, find a number of classes from salsa and hip hop dance to kung fu for kids or adults. And it is one of the only places in the country where you can see massive African baobab trees.

The city of Hollywood – with its lush parks, stunning ocean views, artsy vibe, small, independent shops, restaurants, and luxury amenities – is a destination for the outdoorsy, culture enthusiast or even resort-dweller.



HOLLYWOOD BEACH BROADWALK, THEATER AND ACTIVITIES

▶ Recognized as one of Travel + Leisure's top boardwalks, this 2.5-mile stretch offers breathtaking ocean views. Discover more than 50 cafes, markets, juice bars and ice cream parlors.

Luxury accommodations like the Margaritaville Hollywood Beach Resort and The Diplomat Beach Resort await, while three charming parks provide a haven for families.

Street and garage parking are available, with a public trolley. For cycling or rollerblading, rental shops dot the promenade.

The 500-seat Hollywood Beach Theatre hosts live music from reggae and rock to pop and Latin. This open-air venue presents a free concert every Wednesday through Sunday. To cap off the night, head to one of the nearby restaurants and bars for an oceanfront dinner or cocktail.

▶ Inspired by the laid-back vibe of Jimmy Buffett, Margaritaville Hollywood Beach Resort is an 18-story, 369-room beachfront property offering a full slate of entertainment. Thrill-seekers can catch some waves on the resort's FlowRider, a stationary wave attraction. The renowned St. Somewhere Spa beckons with pampering.

Satisfy your cravings at the signature Margaritaville Restaurant, where coastal-inspired cuisine and Jimmy Buffett's legendary cheeseburgers take center stage, with a two-story seascape to overlook. For cocktails with a view, try License to Chill Bar atop the 11th floor rooftop terrace. Meanwhile, the 5 o'Clock Somewhere Bar and Grill serenades guests with live entertainment along the Intracoastal.

In addition to in-shop pieces, Hollywood Hot Glass has expanded to offer interactive classes aboard Celebrity Cruises. Now, cruise guests can capture their experiences in a one-of-a-kind memento like a starfish or ornament.

EXTREME RAGE PAINTBALL PARK

▲ Rated the No. 1 paintball park in South Florida and home to the pro team Miami Rage, Extreme Rage Paintball Park is a more than 20-year-old family-owned business that caters to the paintball novice or expert. There are three playing arenas, including one airball and two wooded fields, which can accommodate up to 150 players. All are lit at night and welcome events from birthday parties to corporate team-building.

The wooded areas have hills, tunnels, machine gun bunkers and even a five-bedroom house to simulate living quarters. During specialized scenario games, players can expect to be met with smoke machines and mock grenades for an extra thrill.

Fields are open Fridays through Sundays and by reservation only from Monday through Thursday. All players must complete a waiver to play.

This well-known Intracoastal waterway provides a boating haven that makes Hollywood a true destination.

Dock and enjoy lunch at the 5 o'Clock Somewhere Bar and Grill.

For an emphasis on nature, Salty Soul Adventures offers guided tours throughout South Florida, including kayaking, snorkeling and more. You'll learn about the area's important ecological elements while seeing the sights up close.

Still looking for more fun? On the interior side of the Intracoastal, Holland Park offers a popular observation deck, where a short climb promises some of the best panoramic views of the ocean, waterway and cityscape.

DINING

Back on land, you'll need somewhere to eat. Thankfully that's easy to find along this stretch of coastline.

Billy's Stone Crab, located on the waterway, is a popular pick for fresh crab and seafood — and its west-facing locale means you can get an amazing sunset view.

For a more casual meal, At Peru Restaurant offers incredible authentic Peruvian specialties, with a terrace and oceanfront location perfect for getting your toes sandy.

Blue Wave Argentinian Gastropub is another hopping spot for fresh Argentinian food.

BOATING, TOURS, AND DINNER CRUISES

With water on both sides of Ocean Boulevard, Hollywood's main seaside thoroughfare, opportunities abound to enjoy Florida's gorgeous weather.

Rent your own vessel from Boatsetter in Hollywood. Charter a yacht or rent a boat from Hollywood Boat Rentals for an unforgettable excursion.



OTHER ADVENTURES

For smaller craft, check out Waterway Adventures to choose from guided water trips by paddle board, kayak or water taxi. They have a Mangrove and Margarita tour through the local mangrove mazes that ends with a free margarita at local hot spot 5 o'Clock Somewhere Bar and Grill.

Ultimate Florida Tours also offers options for the outdoor adventure-seeker, from a relaxing segway outing to jet-ski rentals, helicopter tours and thrilling airboat rides.

THE Hard Rock



Just a few minutes from Hollywood's downtown area, Seminole Hard Rock Hotel & Casino provides the ideal spot to stay for anyone who has both entertainment and ease top of mind.

There are three large hotels on the property, the grandest of which — The Guitar Hotel — is a sweeping, all-glass structure shaped like its namesake instrument and well-appointed with luxury. Each hotel is replete with amazing views of the city, and guests have easy access to all the amenities the mammoth complex boasts.

Hop between several pools, including a beach-inspired swimming hole festooned with lounge chairs, an elaborate tropical, lagoon-style pool, and a massive open water area where you can even row on a canoe or paddle board.

Six fine dining restaurants include a specialty steak and seafood spot and a caviar lounge. For a more casual experience, there are seven relaxed eateries to choose from, including (of course) a Hard Rock Cafe, a sports bar, pool bar, beach bar and deli. Quick bites are available at the food court, while overnight guests can get room service brought right to bed. Eleven bars offer a range of settings — from upscale, chic date spots to rowdy sports bars.

And try your luck at the largest casino in South Florida with more than 3,000 slot machines, 200 table games and a poker room with 45 active tables.

Finally, entertainment here is in plentiful supply. Hard Rock Live — the campus' largest event venue — holds up to 7,000 excited fans and hosts massive, A-list performances, sporting events and award shows. There's also an incredible comedy club presenting local and nationally touring acts, as well as the DAER night (and day) club.

THE HOLLYWOOD HIP STRIP

Running east to west, between Dixie Highway and Young Circle, is a half mile strip of boutiques, restaurants, nightlife and activities for retail therapy and other entertainment.

On this short stretch of Hollywood Boulevard, you can sip cocktails with friends after work, enjoy a romantic date night, indulge in a hookah sesh or partake in the vibrant music and dance scene at the many late-night lounges.

Sports fans flock to Mickey Byrne's Irish Pub for traditional food and beer as massive flat screens display the games. At Tekila Bar Club, there's a happy hour with

drinks starting at \$5, Instagramable "rainbow shots," and on nights when there's no DJ or live music, warm up your vocal chords for karaoke.

Peruvian, Colombian, Caribbean fare and more dot the boulevard, with popular choices like Sajna Indian Cuisine and The Greek Joint Kitchen & Bar, while Oaxaka offers unique Mexican-Asian fusion. C.L.A.S.S. Soiree Steakhouse is an upscale fine dining establishment serving steak, chops and seafood

with the option to book the entire restaurant for a special date night or event.

Practice rumba, samba and merengue at Spice Resto-Lounge — an upscale bar and nightclub featuring tropical cocktails, live Latin music, professional cabaret dancers and even free salsa dancing classes.

The Hollywood Hip Strip is a one-stop shop to satisfy all of your shopping and entertainment needs.

Orangebrook Golf & Country Club.

The first stop is Hollywood Beach Golf Club, a striking par-70, 18-hole course operating since the 1920s that still feels like stepping into vintage Florida. The course sits on a stunning 110 acres and offers challenges for every golfer. Tee off down narrow fairways, test your skills on a variety of bunkers and traps, and maneuver around classic water hazards, all with lush landscapes around each curve. The clubhouse features a pro shop and some of the best burgers around at Grill 1924.

Just a few minutes away, and operated by the same owners, Eco Golf Club is an ideal alternative for those tight on time or looking for a less daunting challenge. This nine-hole course may take half the time, but it

features plenty of the same water hazards and exciting traps. Sharp doglegs in some areas present keen obstacles to play through. Test your skills with a shorter outing at this well-kept, par-32 property.

The tour shouldn't end without a day at Orangebrook Golf & Country Club. This impressive facility has two 18-hole courses as well as a driving range for extra practice. Each course is stacked with features for golfers from novice to expert, and both end with a particularly challenging hole to test your skills. Champions who have played here include World Golf Hall of Fame inductee Peggy Kirk Bell and Jack William Nicklaus, one of the greatest golfers of all time.



The Hollywood Beach Broadwalk.

Boasting panoramic ocean views and nearly 2.5 miles of brick walkway with eats, treats and space to roam, Hollywood Beach is a lovely place to spend the day. It is recognized as one of Florida's most family-friendly beaches, so bring the kids for swimming, sandcastles and ice cream or get friends together for a pick up volleyball game on the sand.

Stroll down the palm tree-lined pedestrian path called the Hollywood Broadwalk with small shops and eateries on one side and the salty ocean breeze on the other. Take a seat on the wave wall separating the promenade from the shore as cyclists and rollerbladers zoom past. Further south, Margaritaville Hollywood Beach Resort offers relaxing oceanside amenities as well as action packed-activities, like the Flowrider surf simulator, accessible to both visitors and locals.

The Downtown Hollywood Mural Project is an art aficionado's dream destination, featuring miles of walkable art. Buildings and walls-turned-canvas can be viewed casually when strolling around Downtown Hollywood, but the city also offers complimentary nightly guided walking tours of these towering spectacles. And, on the third Saturday of each month, ArtWalk attendees can often observe a master muralist at work.

Launched in 2012 by the Hollywood Community Redevelopment Agency, there are nearly 30 murals scattered around the outskirts of Young Circle. Stroll down South 20th Avenue, and you'll come upon vibrant pink flamingos more than 10 feet tall. Turn another corner, and see a wall of pouty lips by famed mural artist Diana Contreras outside Labios Kitchen & Lounge. From nature-themed landscapes to spray painted cartoon creatures, the murals of Downtown Hollywood are diverse, awe-inspiring and highly Instagrammable. Just wear comfortable shoes!

HOLLYWOOD

RESTAURANTS

On Hollywood’s famous Boardwalk indulge in flights of craft beer, lobster rolls, gourmet steak, chilled oysters or juicy burgers. Inland, further from the coast, dine on Brazilian bites, oversized glazed donuts and other palate pleasers like Mexican-Asian fusion.



BILLY’S STONE CRAB

Everyone flock to this high-end, waterfront locale with beautiful views for the stone crabs, best accompanied by Billy’s signature mustard sauce. Don’t feel like going out? Order them by the pound for an at-home feast. If stone crabs aren’t in season, not to worry – this menu is filled with fresh fish of the day, entrees prepared blackened or with Mediterranean, Caribbean and other seasonings. Begin your repast with oysters Rockefeller or New England clam chowder before diving into your entree.

Peruvian flavors, in a variety of quick, comfort food options like hearty sandwiches and empanadas or healthy options such as quinoa bowls, set this modern sandwich bar apart. 
