Meanwhile, cowboy swagger is alive and well in the college town of Davie. Visitors can discover the city's distinctive Western persona by watching masterful horse wrangling at Bergeron Rodeo Grounds. Nature-lovers will enjoy a stroll through Tree Tops Park or Flamingo Gardens.

Nearby, Plantation sets contemporary living within abundant natural environs. Enjoy the outdoors while practicing your putt at Plantation Preserve Golf Course and Club, or discover glimpses of the past at Plantation Historical Museum. Then shop your heart out in style on the University Drive corridor at Broward Mall or The Fountains.

You'll find lots more than big name entertainment spots and tourist-friendly activities in Greater Fort Lauderdale's west-central communities. The vibrant residents who live, work and play in these suburbs enjoy amenities and resources that visitors might also appreciate, once they know where to look.

## SUNRISE

An area once made famous by the upside down house where visitors could stroll on the ceiling and touch furniture bolted above their heads, Sunrise has grown quite a bit since its incorporation in 1961. Today, the city is bordered by three major thoroughfares, I-595, I-75 and the Sawgrass Expressway. It is a quick 20-minute drive from Fort Lauderdale's pristine beaches to the east, and adjacent to the Everglades conservation area to the west.

For new residents or those with longer-term needs, there are multiple car dealerships at the west end of Sunrise Boulevard, as well as Greater Fort Lauderdale's only IKEA store. Sunrise is home to the largest corporate office park in South Florida, the 612-acre Sawgrass International Corporate Park, where major companies have regional and South American headquarters. And they're extremely proud of their internationally-recognized chess initiative, once being named Chess City USA.

## DAVIE

A sprawling city just south of I-595, Davie feels like a slice of old-school country in the middle of the modern world. Founded in the area originally called Zona, Davie was a patch of swamp drained for farmland by its namesake developer Robert Parsell Davie. Davie's original schoolhouse still exists as a museum, and its education-based legacy has flourished. A bonafide college town, here you'll find many leading institutions of higher education, including Nova Southeastern University, Broward College, McFatter Technical Center and more.

Movie buffs might recognize the Rolling Hills Golf Course as the backdrop of the movie "Caddyshack." You can also connect with pristine nature on the grounds of Flamingo Gardens.

## PLANTATION

With a population of fewer than 500 and a budget of \$1,288, the city of Plantation was incorporated on April 30, 1953. The developer of this area that was once Everglades wetlands envisioned large lots where fruit trees could be planted, and each home would be unique. Over half a century later, that roomy flora-rich aesthetic remains, with safe neighborhoods and often opulent homes "situated among thousands of trees." The city's aesthetic is enhanced by signature, quaint red brick facades. Plantation is now a bustling city that offers the amenities of a faster paced downtown, home to organizations like Virgin Voyages and Chewy, but with much more hometown charm.

In recent years, Plantation has received designations such as "City of the Future," "Tree City," and "100 Best Communities for Young People." There's a hub of corporate and banquet event activity at the Renaissance Fort Lauderdale-Plantation Hotel. And fun fact: during the 100th anniversary of the Olympic games in 1996, the Olympic flame passed through the center of the city.

# ESSENTIAL ATTRACTIONS

The cities of Sunrise, Davie and Plantation each masterfully balance quaint suburban charm with modern entertainment.

**B**ordered by two major highways, Sunrise is central to all of South Florida's most sought-after amenities. Though its most famous landmarks are Sawgrass Mills Mall and Amerant Bank Arena, there's plenty of other activities to do, including skeet shooting, water sports, golf and cultural arts.

Once part of the Everglades wetlands, Plantation continues to maintain lots of outdoor greenspace. The city has a lifestyle suited for both athletes and artists, where you can bounce your way to fitness, learn about diverse communities, or mozy along an open trail on horseback.

The college town of Davie is home to modern amenities for sports fans and thrill-seekers, but it also hangs on to an unusual pioneer lifestyle. Residents and visitors can spend a day at the rodeo, an evening with the arts or an afternoon browsing relics of local history.

## SUNRISE

### MARKHAM PARK

► Visitors will find a 669-acre park with a nine-hole disc golf course, 88 campground sites, a dog park, remote-controlled airplane field, mountain bike trails from novice to pro, playgrounds and tennis-racquetball courts at Markham Park, near the intersection of Everglades Parkway and the Sawgrass Expressway. The facility boasts a 26-acre lake and a marina stocked with boats available for hourly rental. And you can gain access to the Everglades by boat.

Campsites are full-hookup and have a picnic table, fire ring or barbeque grill and access to two restrooms with shower facilities. Primitive camp sites are also available for scouting groups.

The jewel of Markham Park is the target range. Sportspeople can enjoy the skeet and trap venue, pistol and rifle range, and a sporting clays course.

### SUNRISE CIVIC CENTER THEATRE AND ART GALLERY

► Opened as part of the Sunrise Civic Center in 1998, the Theatre and Art Gallery includes a 300-seat theater with mezzanine, full production stage that hosts a variety of performing arts, an outdoor amphitheater and traveling art exhibits, including the work of local artists.

Constantly changing, the Art Gallery plays host to multiple exhibitions annually. Admission is free, and visitors have the opportunity to meet the featured artists.

The theater also boasts a myriad of performance genres. The calendar offers everything from children's productions to dance ensembles, plays and concerts.

Its intimate setting offers audience members the opportunity to see the productions up close and personal. With more than double the theater's capacity, the outdoor amphitheater is home of the popular "Tunes 'N Trucks" seasonal concert series.

### PLANTATION EQUESTRIAN CENTER

◀ Since opening in 2005, the center has hosted horse shows and exhibitions every weekend. The facility features two large stables with 96 stalls, three show rings with an additional two practice rings, grassy paddock areas, seating for 300, and a building with restrooms and a concession stand. This is set against the backdrop of 85 acres of nature trails, bridle paths through wetlands, auditory sculptures that react to environmental elements and playgrounds for the kids.

### PLANTATION HISTORICAL MUSEUM

## OLD DAVIE SCHOOL HISTORICAL MUSEUM

The eye-catching Amerant Bank Arena is one of South Florida's most extraordinary sights to see.

With an event center cited among the best in the world, Amerant Bank Arena attracts more than two million guests each year with a thrilling lineup of sports, concerts, and unforgettable entertainment.

Not only is it home to the National Hockey League's Florida Panthers, but this sprawling venue also sets the stage for some of the most monumental events in Florida. From sold-out concerts by superstars like Billy Joel, Elton John, Bruce Springsteen, Lady Gaga and Beyoncé, to mesmerizing family performances and prestigious award shows, the arena has hosted an impressive lineup of mega-stars. It has also played host to productions such as Disney On Ice, Cirque du Soleil,

Monster Jam and Jurassic Quest.

In 1998, following a triumphant conference championship win, the National Hockey League's Florida Panthers made the move from Miami to the arena. Every season, fervent hockey fans from all across Florida flock to the Sunrise area to cheer on their beloved Panthers. As the southernmost team in the league, the Cats have captivated fans and produced legendary players like Pavel "The Russian Rocket" Bure, who have been rightfully inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame. In 2023, the Panthers made history by winning the team's first playoff sweep and making it to the second Stanley Cup Final since the franchise's last Finals appearance in 1996.

Davie residents are known for their deep love of all things equestrian — a significant portion of the population owns horses and hundreds once rode to a town council meeting to protest a plan to tear down the rodeo arena.

**T**he Bergeron Rodeo Grounds stands at the heart of Davie. After the arena was saved by the 1978 horseback protest, the Davie Rodeo Association was formed as part of an effort spearheaded by rodeo star Troy Weekley and Ron Bergeron Sr., a former rodeo champ who also is the subject of Tanya Tucker's song, "Alligator Man."

The Town of Davie named the arena Bergeron Rodeo Grounds in honor of the family's contributions to the sport and town itself. Bergeron's father, Percy, founded the local grocery and was among the area leaders who brought rodeo to the small town with big spirit. Bergeron, 77, hung up his ropes in 2018, but the tradition continues with his six children, who he introduced to the sport as they drove across the country for rodeos.

Today, rodeo is still the heart of Davie, drawing thousands of people for weekly regional exhibitions,

Professional Rodeo Cowboy Association events every other month, and the PRCA Southeastern Circuit Finals each November. The Davie Arena at Bergeron Rodeo Grounds, which is available to rent, boasts 72,000 square feet of indoor-outdoor space with seating for 5,000 people. But there is a lot more than just horsing around. The complex hosts a number of town-sponsored events, such as the Davie Jazz Festival and the Taste of Davie. Visitors can also enjoy the occasional concert or monster truck show.

Plans for commercial and residential development keep Davie's Western style at the center of architecture and atmosphere. The walkable downtown will feature frontier-styled wood railings, vintage lanterns and buildings in earth-tone colors to honor the look of what was past while incorporating modern convenience and ingenuity.

# Flamingo Gardens



Home to some of the last natural jungle in South Florida, Flamingo Gardens is a lush tropical paradise. The 60 acres of property include breathtaking botanical gardens brimming with more than 3,000 tropical, subtropical and native plants.

The onsite Everglades Wildlife Sanctuary features a variety of rescued fauna, including black bears, panthers, bobcats, alligators, peacocks and, of course, flamingos. The sanctuary is Florida's largest collection of native wildlife with over 85 native species and a team that provides a safe haven for injured birds and animals unable to re-enter the wild.





Nature lovers are welcome to stroll along meandering pathways in the main arboretum, cool under the shade of some of Florida's largest trees, including the largest single-trunk tree in the state. Bromeliads, crotons, butterflies and hummingbirds have distinct places of their own in the specialty gardens nestled along the way. Take the guided tram tour through the property, then stop at the flamingo pond and feed these gentle, wading birds.

Surrounded by a sweeping hammock of two-century-old live oaks blanketed in orchids, ferns and air plants is the historic Wray Home Museum. Built in the early 1930s, this recently restored building offers a window to the past with valued heirlooms on display. History and nature happily coexist here in the heart of Flamingo Gardens.
