Today, you can tour several moonshine distilleries around town to see just how the century-old Appalachian tradition has evolved (and, in some cases, stayed exactly the same) over the years. You can enjoy a sip of the strong stuff at just about any of the bars along the Parkway, too! Whether you get a taster, a flight, or an expertly mixed cocktail, we wholly recommend you give the 'shine a go.

If liquor is a little too hard to handle, take it easy with a taste of Tennessee's finest wineries. There are five located around town, and you can hit them all when you follow the Gatlinburg Wine Trail. Purchase your VIP Trail Pass at any of the participating locations, and if you happen to visit each of the wineries within a week's time, you'll win a free gift! But even if you don't score the special giveaway, a bottle of wine makes a pretty great consolation prize if you ask us.
