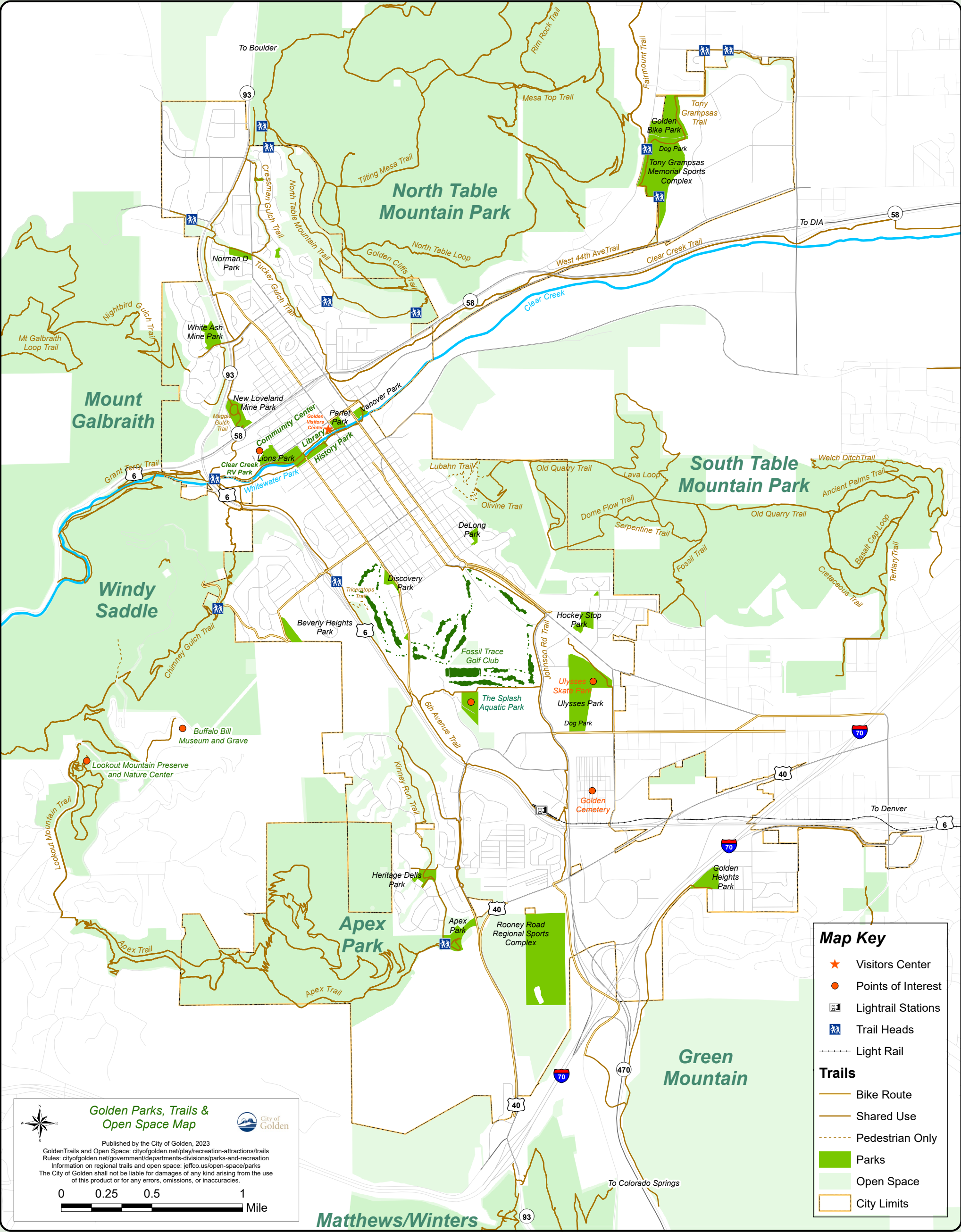

Easy to moderate		West side of mesa, south side of mesa, east side of mesa	Parking north of Golden on Hwy 93 just north of Pine Ridge Road, parking near Peery Pkwy, parking at Tony Grampsas Memorial Sports Complex	Hiking, mountain biking, climbing and horseback riding	Sanctuary for abundant wildlife, excellent views of Golden Valley. Lichen Peak Trail leads to park's highest peak.
Grant Terry Trail	.7 mile	30 min.	Easy		Access the trail via the Clear Creek Trail west of Clear Creek RV Park	Free parking	Hiking, biking	Wide compact dirt trail
Kinney Run Trail	.75 mile	30 min. to 1.5 hrs.	Moderate to advanced	50 ft.	Access the trail via the Apex parking lot off US Hwy 40	Free parking	Hiking, biking	Taxing trail with great views of Denver/South Platte Valley
Lubahn Trail	2.5 mile loop	30 min. to 1.5 hrs.	Moderate	400 ft.	Access the trail via Belvedere Dr. and 19th St.	Street parking	Hiking	Loop trail in the gulley below and south of Castle Rock on South Table Mtn.
Olivine Trail	.5 mile	15 min. to 30 min.	Easy		Access the trail via the Lubahn Trail.	Street parking	Hiking, biking	Connector trail from the Lubahn Trail to Old Quarry Trail which leads to South Table Mountain Park
Magpie Gulch Trail		30 min. to 1.5 hrs.	Easy		Access the trail along Rubey Drive near Mitchell Elementary School.	Street parking	Hiking, biking	A group of trails connect Golden residential neighborhoods along Hwy 93 to neighborhood schools, the Golden Community Center and the downtown area
Nightbird Gulch Trail	1.8 miles	30 min. to 1.5 hrs.	Moderate to advanced		Access the trail at the Jefferson County Trailhead, 21992 Golden Gate Canyon Rd, Golden, CO 80403.	Street parking	Hiking only	Provides access to Mount Galbraith Park and is rough, with many rock steps and ledges
Tony Grampsas Memorial Sports Complex Trail	1.3 miles	30 min. to 1.5 hrs.	Easy		Access the trail east of Tony Grampsas Gym on Salvia St., on Easley Road or at west 50th Ave. and Quaker Lane	Free parking	Hiking, biking	Easy trail that follows the west side of the Park often following the church ditch shade
Tucker Gulch Trail	1.5 miles	30 min. to 1.5 hrs.	Easy to moderate	50 ft.	Access the trail via Vanover or Norman D. Park	Free parking	Hiking, mountain biking	Uphill paved trail beginning at Vanover Park in Downtown Golden at the Clear Creek Trail and travels up the Tucker Gulch drainage
6th Ave. Trail	2.5 miles	1 to 2 hrs.	Easy to moderate		19th St. and Hwy 6	No designated parking lot	Hiking, biking	A critical north-south regional trail along Hwy 6 connecting to regional trail systems
Fairmount Trail	3 miles	1 to 2 hrs.	Easy	50 ft.	Access the south end of the trail at Tony Grampsas Park	Free Parking	Hiking, biking, horseback riding	Easy natural surface trail
South Table Mountain	4 miles	30 min. to 1.5 hrs.	Moderate		Access the park at 1220 Kilmer St.	Street parking	Hiking, mountain biking	Open space property with prize habitat for cliff-nesting raptors and panoramic mesa-top views
Triceratops Trail	1.5 miles	30 min. to 1.5 hrs.	Easy	50 ft.	Access the trailhead via the parking lot at 6th Ave. and 19th St.	Paid parking	Hiking	Gravel hiking trail that winds between large, vertical walls of sandstone with invertebrate tracks
