Colorado Classic to Zoom Through Golden on August 24th – Golden hosts the third stage of the 2019 Colorado Classic, the only women's stand-alone stage race in the Western Hemisphere on the Union Cyclists Internationale calendar and USA Cycling's Pro Road Tour. The race begins at 11;30 under Golden's Welcome Arch. Visit the free wellness EXPO at Parfet Park from 10 a.m.– 2 p.m.
