



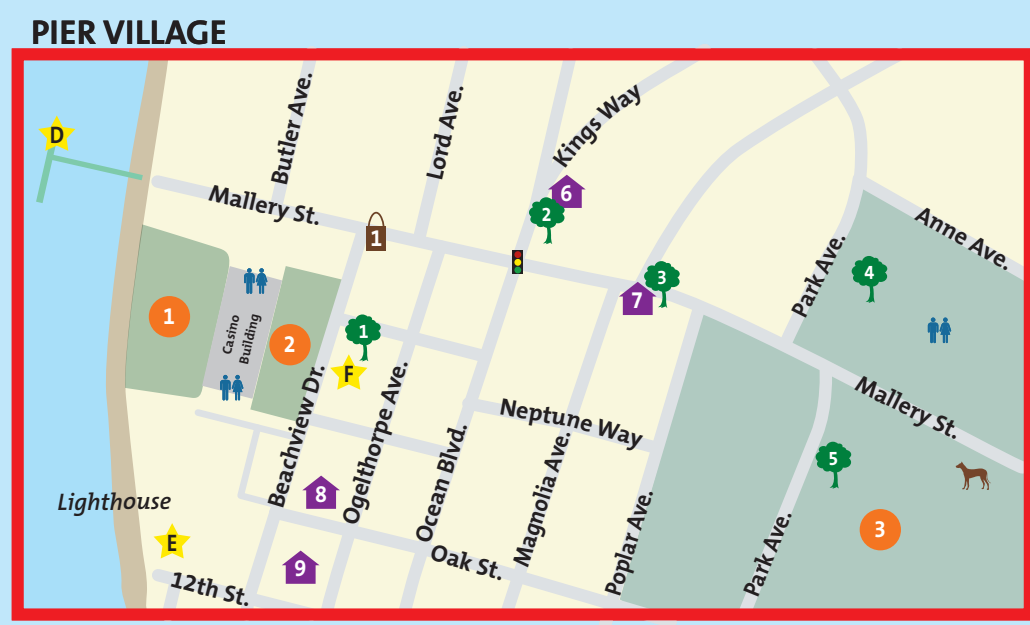

\*\*Multi-use\* means paths may be shared with pedestrians, roller skaters, cyclists, motor vehicles, etc. Pedestrians have the right of way on these paths. To be considered pedestrians, cyclists must dismount and walk their bikes, including when crossing streets. Narrow, rural, or multi-use roads are part of our local charm, but be aware some paths offer little or no shoulder for cyclists. Cyclists are responsible for knowing the rules of the road and evaluating their own comfort riding on multi-use trails that may parallel or intersect with vehicular traffic. Please remain alert for motor vehicles on all multi-use trails. Georgia law requires all cyclists under the age of 16 to wear a helmet, although we recommend cyclists of all ages wear helmets.
