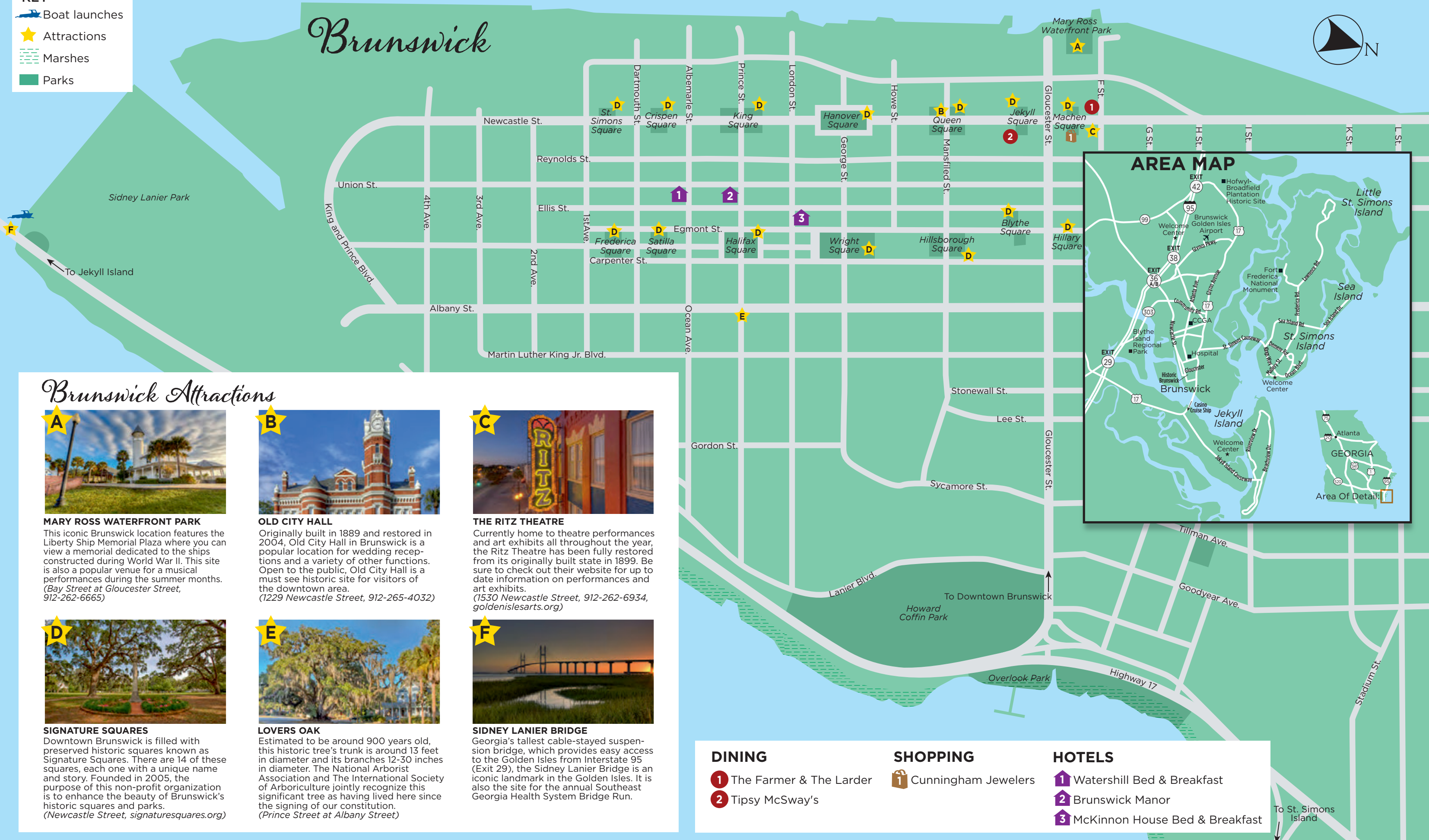

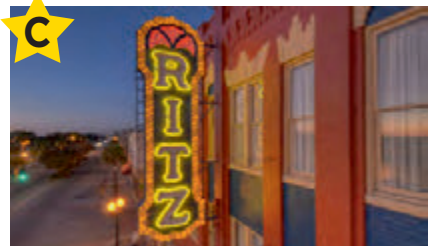
# Brunswick Attractions



**MARY ROSS WATERFRONT PARK**  
This iconic Brunswick location features the Liberty Ship Memorial Plaza where you can view a memorial dedicated to the ships constructed during World War II. This site is also a popular venue for a musical performances during the summer months. (Bay Street at Gloucester Street, 912-262-6665)



**OLD CITY HALL**  
Originally built in 1889 and restored in 2004, Old City Hall in Brunswick is a popular location for wedding receptions and a variety of other functions. Open to the public, Old City Hall is a must see historic site for visitors of the downtown area. (1229 Newcastle Street, 912-265-4032)



**THE RITZ THEATRE**  
Currently home to theatre performances and art exhibits all throughout the year, the Ritz Theatre has been fully restored from its originally built state in 1899. **SIGNATURE SQUARES**  
Downtown Brunswick is filled with preserved historic squares known as Signature Squares. There are 14 of these squares, each one with a unique name and story. Founded in 2005, the purpose of this non-profit organization is to enhance the beauty of Brunswick's historic squares and parks. (Newcastle Street, signaturesquares.org)



**LOVERS OAK**  
Estimated to be around 900 years old, this historic tree's trunk is around 13 feet in diameter and its branches 12-30 inches in diameter. The National Arborist Association and The International Society of Arboriculture jointly recognize this significant tree as having lived here since the signing of our constitution. (Prince Street at Albany Street)



**SIDNEY LANIER BRIDGE**  
Georgia's tallest cable-stayed suspension bridge, which provides easy access to the Golden Isles from Interstate 95 (Exit 29), the Sidney Lanier Bridge is an iconic landmark in the Golden Isles. It is also the site for the annual Southeast Georgia Health System Bridge Run.
