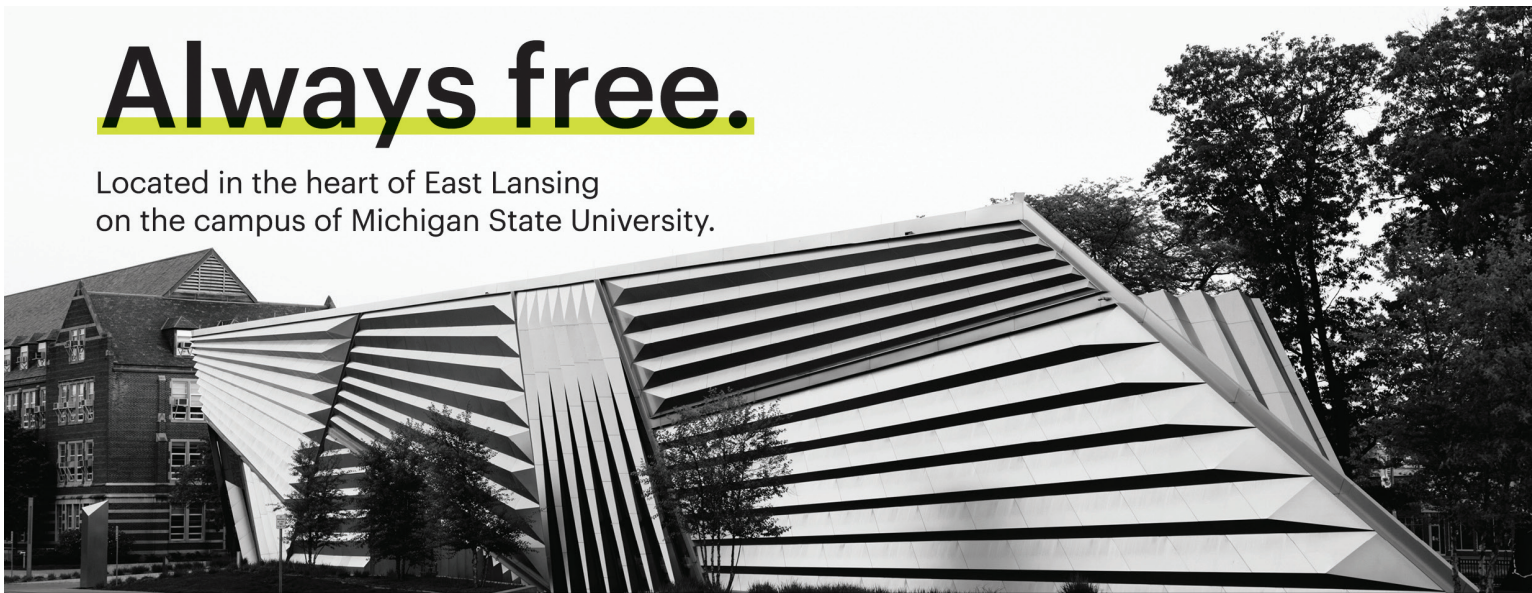

How Does ArtPrize Work?

Artists & Venues

ArtPrize is an independently organized event where every spring our venues and our artists register and connect to bring their visions to life! Venues can be anything from museums, bars and auto repair shops to coffee houses, civic centers and restaurants. Artists are welcome to submit any type of work and venues are encouraged to uniquely activate their space for what has become one of Grand Rapids' premier events for visitors to enjoy. ArtPrize works closely with the city to activate public spaces in the ArtPrize districts. Compelling venues outside of the district can become satellite venues as well.

Juried Awards

This year, \$62,500 will be awarded to artists by a panel of jurors. Jurors are selected based on their expertise and experience, they are highly qualified art professionals from various cities and institutions. There is a dedicated juror for each entry category who is tasked with judging entries in order to decide on the awards. There is a \$10,000 winner and a \$2,500 honorable mention for each category.

Categories

2-D

Entries that exist primarily on a flat plane. Painting, drawing, photography, printmaking, and most textiles are examples of 2-D work.

3-D

Entries that occupy space and are intended to be viewed from multiple angles.

Time-Based

Entries that are durational and can have multiple iterations. The viewer has to spend some time with the work to fully view it. This includes performance, video, film, dance, music, and interactive work.

Installation

Entries that are dependent on the site in which they are installed. The location is not a neutral ground, but makes up an important ingredient of the work. Installation is different from 3-D in that changing the location of the piece would dramatically change the work.

Digital

Entries that can be displayed electronically through a screen such as TVs, tablets, projection equipment, etc.

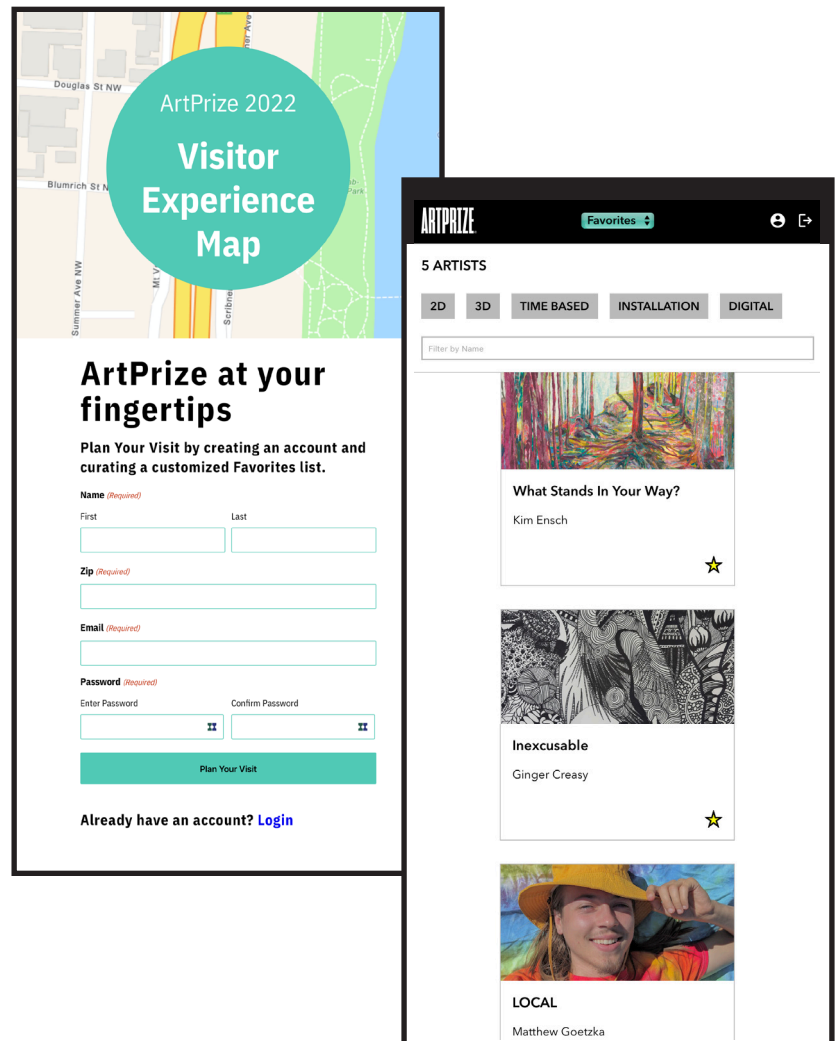

Step 2: Find & Add Your Favorite Artists

After you've created your visitor profile, you can add artists to your **Favorites List**. Your list will help you navigate, connect and revisit your favorite art, artists, and venues during ArtPrize. Each artist you add to your **Favorites List** will also have the chance of winning one of the many daily, weekly and end-of-event prizes ranging from \$250 to \$2500. The **Favorites List** will also be used to award \$10,000 to one artist from each of the five categories (2-D, 3-D, Time-Based, Installation and Digital).



*Existing ArtPrize accounts are no longer valid, everyone will need to create a new account in order to create a **Favorites List**.

Prize Money

\$250k in Total Prizes!

For 18 days, art is exhibited throughout the city in public parks and museums, in galleries and storefronts, in restaurants and on bridges. This year ArtPrize will award \$450,000 directly to artists, through grants and prizes. \$175,000 will be awarded through visitors' favorite lists and \$62,500 will be awarded through juried selection and an artist prize.

Prizes

\$250–\$2,500 in prizes will be awarded throughout the event on a daily and weekly basis. Prizes may include:

Artist-to-Artist Prize

At the end of the event, artists will have a chance to award another participating artist (or artist-collaborative team) the \$12,500 Artist-to-Artist Award. Artists will have one vote and may not vote for themselves.

This year we dedicated \$10,000 in grant money to an artist from our 3rd Ward to bring their work to ArtPrize, thanks to WOOD TV8, Rockford Construction, and DTE Energy Foundation. Edwin Anderson rose to the challenge and installed a basketball court mural in McKay-Jaycee Park for the community to enjoy during ArtPrize and beyond.

Pitch Night Arizona

ArtPrize launched Pitch Night in 2013 as a means of discovering exciting, ambitious projects across the country. Artists from partner regions are invited to present their proposals in five minutes to a panel of five local art experts. This year's Pitch Night Arizona winner is ***El Sueño Americano*** by Tom Kiefer from Ajo, AZ and will be on view at DeVos Center.

Ride The Rapid

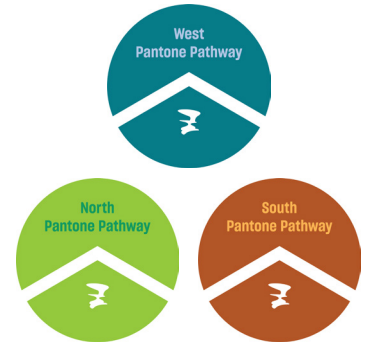

K-12 Education

Actively teaching the art and artists of ArtPrize, Cultivate has created three magazines (grades K-3, 4-8, 9-12) that are common core standardized and can be a resource for art teachers and students year-round. These magazines will be distributed to art classrooms and schools across West Michigan and available at ArtPrize Education Days events.

- Where are you from?
How does that affect your work?
- Has your art style changed over time?
- What dialogue do you hope this work inspires others to have?
- Is this the whole body of work or just a portion of it? Is it ongoing?

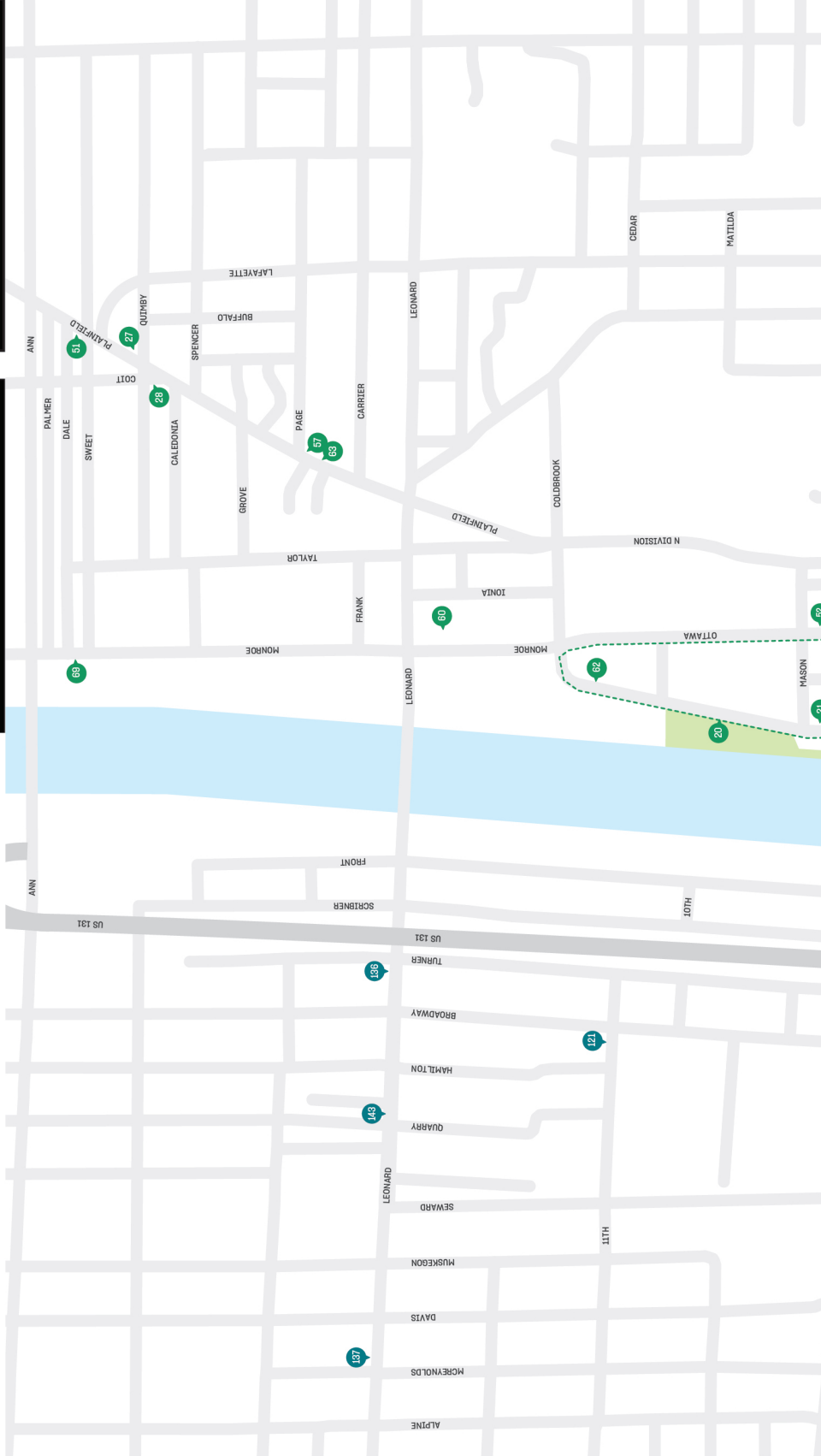
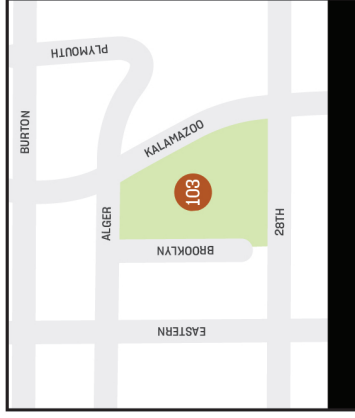


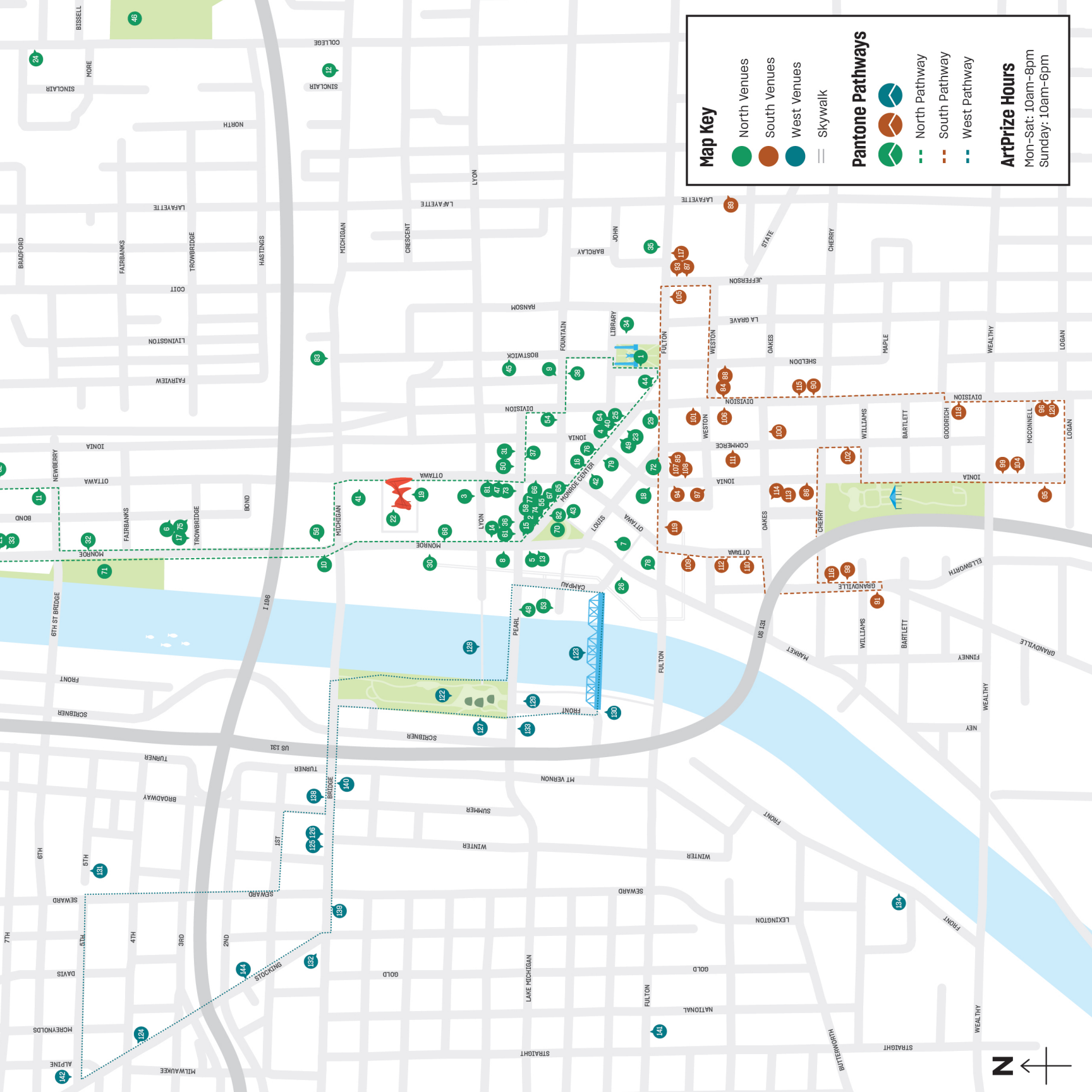
