Traveling to Grapevine by train is a breeze. Texas has three **Amtrak®** lines that connect to major cities including Chicago, Los Angeles, Oklahoma City, Tucson and New Orleans. The Texas Eagle and Heartland Flyer lines bring passengers to Fort Worth Central Station, who can then switch to the new **Trinity Metro TEXRail** commuter train eastbound to Grapevine Main Station.

TRINITY METRO TEXRAIL®

Launched in 2019, Trinity Metro **TEXRail** takes passengers to nine stations over 27 miles between Dallas Fort Worth International (DFW) Airport and Downtown Fort Worth. The all-aluminum cars are powered by mechanical units in the center of the trains. TEXRail operates seven days a week, 24 hours a day and offers USB charging stations and free Wi-Fi among other amenities.

GRAPEVINE MAIN STATION

Deboard **TEXRail** at the elegant, new **Grapevine Main Station**, which harkens back to the grand train stations of the 19th century. Inside this transit-oriented landmark is **Harvest Hall**, a European-style food hall featuring seven globally-inspired kitchens. Dine at a table inside the Great Hall or take your food outside for an alfresco dining experience on the expansive **Peace Plaza**, which hosts free concerts. Book a stay at the adjacent **Hotel Vin**, a 120-room boutique hotel, or catch a complimentary visitors shuttle to another of Grapevine's hotels.

Grapevine Main Station is situated at the south end of Grapevine's **Historic Main Street District**. This charming, nationally recognized district features one-of-a-kind boutiques, locally owned bistros and cafés and winery tasting rooms all within walking distance of Grapevine Main Station.

WHILE IN GRAPEVINE

Every visitor to Grapevine should experience a ride on the **Grapevine Vintage Railroad (GVR)**. Departing from the original 1888 Cotton Belt Depot, GVR offers short, one-hour excursions as well as a round-trip journey to the Historic Stockyards Station in Fort Worth aboard lovingly restored 1920s-era Victorian-style coaches.

Visit the **Lone Star Hi-Railers** model train layout located at 5410 W. Dallas Road. It is housed in a vintage baggage car on static display behind the #711 Baldwin Mikado 2-8-2 steam engine.

**Please note, GVR's 2248 is currently undergoing 15-year maintenance, but is expected to be back in service later this year.*

GRAPEVINE VINTAGE RAILROAD

All aboard! Enjoy the golden age of railroad and ride along the Cotton Belt Route most weekends throughout the year. **GVR** coaches are pulled by either a 1953 GP-7 diesel locomotive nicknamed "Vinny" or one of two EMD FL9 locomotives. The onboard experience is the Great Train Heist, an interactive performance where guests help railroad detectives solve the mystery of who robbed the Grapevine Vintage Railroad.
