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




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Bingham Family Vineyards

Explore one of the largest selections of 100% Texas grown estate wines across Texas at the Hye, Roanoke, Grapevine, or Meadow locations. Dirt Farmer, 2019

Red: Blends (<1.5%)

The French call it terroir; in Texas, we call it dirt. Nurturing the soil, the farmer encourages healthy vines, producing fruit which becomes wonderful wine. Bright fruit forward notes blended with blackberry, black cherry, and raspberry along with spicy pepper, cinnamon, and some black earthiness underneath as well.

Summer Night, 2022

Blush/Rosé

The Texas High Plains experiences extreme climate shifts throughout the growing season with warm days to cool evenings leading to a balanced quality wine. The 2022 Summer Nights bursts with red berry, cranberry, and tropical fruit. The semi sweetness balances the acidity making it the perfect patio wine.

Fine 'n Dandy, 2019

Red: Sweet (>1.5%)

This wine is dedicated to Eddie Bingham, or "Dandy", the grandfather of the family who was dearly loved and respected by all. Semi-sweet, with hints of dried red fruits, leather, and tobacco, this wine is complex. The sweetness balances out the acidity of the wine, softening the tannins. Serve chilled.

Cloudburst, 2022

White: Dry (<1.0%)

This field blend of Albariño and Vermentino gives a nod to the classic Italian Cinque Terre wine blend rooting back to old-world style traditional winemaking practices. The 2022 Cloudburst melds crisp acidity with a delicate bouquet of hay, citrus and green apples with a good sum of minerality.

Moscato, 2021

White: Sweet (>1.5%)

Prepare to be impressed... An extraordinarily rich, complex, absolutely delicious, sweet wine! Begin by smelling the fragrant essence of apricot. Next, taste the sweet, luscious juice that rolls across your palate. Smile, because you're enjoying true nectar of the gods. Perfect with hot spicy foods, or desserts such as chilled fruits or cheesecake.

Sauvignon Blanc, 2021

White: Dry (<1.0%)

Intensely aromatic with ripe citrus, fresh green herbs, and exotic tropical fruits. This is a perfect wine to savor by the glass, yet pairs well with traditional picnic fare; lighter cuisine such as herbed chicken & green salads, or lighter seafood such as red fish, tilapia, and scallops. Serve well chilled.

Rosé, 2021

Blush/Rosé

This is a "perfect" spring/summer/fall wine. The 2021 Rosé truly reflects West Texas terroir. Grown in a high elevation, this wine is an example of what a classic rosé should be: fruity, yet dry; aromatic; food friendly; yet totally enjoyable on its own. When pairing, pair with a fresh salad, salmon, duck, or with a charcuterie and soft cheeses at your next get together. Serve well chilled, at around 45 degrees

Meritage Red Blend, 2018

Red: Blends (<1.5%)

Formerly a true Bordeaux blend, we added just a touch of excellent Texas Tempranillo to this vintage for finishing. Being a 2018 vintage. it has a little age on it now, and is drinking just about perfectly,... full in the mouth, yet the tannins are lush and smooth. If you're a fan of red wines with subtle complexities, you're going to love this one. Wonderful on its own, this wine pairs extremely well with sharp cheddar cheese, grilled butterfly pork chops, or your favorite cut of steak. Serve at a slightly cool temperature of around 65 degrees. Enjoy!!

NORTH TEXAS (DFW)



The Davies family founded the vineyard in 1999. Chardonnay, Viognier, Marsanne, Roussanne, Grenache, Mourvèdre and Syrah are the varieties grown. The winery and tasting room, known as Arché (pronounced ar-khay, meaning beginning, origin or leader) opened in 2007 and offers visitors expansive views of the Red River Valley in northeast Montague County. The tasting room is open Thursdays through Sundays for tastings or to enjoy by the glass. Club members enjoy multiple benefits, including exclusive Club-only wines. In addition to great wine, Arché is also famous for their flatbreads and charcuterie.

Cuvée, 2021

Red: Blends (<1.5%)

34% Merlot, 33% Mourvèdre, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon and 13% Dolcetto. Texas High Plains AVA fruit. Harvest dates from August 28 to October 10, 2021. Bottled September 26, 2022. Dark fruit aromas of blackcurrant and plum with earthy notes of wet stone, layers of herbal notes and undertones of vanilla.

Texas Rose, 2022

Blush/Rosé

Estate-grown saignée rosé. Blend of Syrah, Mourvèdre and Grenache Noir. Pale coral hue with aromas of peach, grapefruit, rose petal and honeydew melon, with a minerality that translates to the palate. Very light bodied with minimal tannins and a nice crispness. Label artwork by Donna Howell Sickles.

Roussanne, 2021

White: Dry (<1.0%)

Estate grown. Hand harvested August 28, 2021. Bottled July 14, 2022. Aromas of white peach, pear and apricot with tones of beeswax and chamomile. Full-bodied white wine with good acidity and a lingering finish. Good aging potential. Peak drinking years 2025 – 2030.

Blue Ostrich Winery and Vineyard has been producing award winning Texas wines for over 12 years. Guests are invited to visit their tasting room near Saint Jo, Texas where wine and food are served Thursday through Sunday year round. Reservations are highly recommended for seating and table service inside the glass-enclosed pavilion that overlooks the beautiful Red River Valley of North Texas. By the way, they really DO have ostriches!

Table One, 2021

Red: Blends (<1.5%)

Three old world grapes blended to create a distinctive Texas wine. Combined aging in both French and American Oak adds a layer of toasty sophistication, and the ruby red color lends to the overall richness of this dry red blend.

Viognier, 2021

White: Dry (<1.0%)

A traditional Rhone style dry white that's perfect for warm latesummer days. Note the classic notes of stone fruits like peach and apricot with an overlay of crisp delicious apple. Best served chilled with light cheeses and mild fish, like grilled trout or tilapia.

Mourvèdre, 2020

Red: Medium (<1.5%)

Deep color and a weighty mouthfeel make this Texas Mourvèdre a good option for those that prefer big, dry red wine styles. This wine is a good companion for grilled meats and hearty Italian or Spanish dishes. Blue Ostrich recommends serving red wines at about 58 degrees with an ever so slight chill.

Rosato Moscato, NV

Blush/Rosé

A sweet and fruity treat for those that enjoy Moscato styles wines. This is a fun wine that great for trip to the lake or football tailgating in the fall. Crafted from 100% Texas muscat grapes, enjoy this rosé ALL DAY!

Checkered Past Winery

Checkered Past Winery was formed in 2008. Owners are Sandro DiSanto and Carolynne Chancellor. The vineyard is located in East Texas but they also buy grapes from growers in the Texas High Plains and Texoma AVA. Checkered Past has produced Albarino, Viognier, Dry Rose', Tempranillo, Malbec, Syrah, Rhone blends, GSM, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese and Riesling Checkered Past had a Wine Pub/Tasting Room/Restaurant in Downtown Dallas from 2015-2020. Now focusing on distribution to restaurants, wine shops and direct to consumer through online sales, festivals and farmers markets.

Two Tone Dry Rosé, 2022

Blush/Rosé

Dry and delicate with fresh flavors of strawberry, citrus, melon, with vibrant acidity and a light mineral finish. This wine is reminiscent of a French Provence style rose' and is gently pressed to create its pale pink color and light body.

Sangiovese, 2021

Red: Medium (<1.5%)

Distinctive flavors of cherry cola, red licorice, and strawberry. It is full-bodied, with a savory, rich fruit taste. The classic Italian grape of Chianti now thrives in Texas.

Tempranillo, 2020

Red: Bold (<1.5%)

This popular wine has flavors of plum, tobacco, espresso bean, and vanilla. Grown on the Texas High Plains AVA and oak-aged for over 12 months to create a full-bodied with smooth tannins that can be enjoyed on its own or with food.

GSM, 2020

Red: Blends (<1.5%)

The classic blend of Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre grapes from the Rhone Valley in Southern France are now grown and produced in Texas. This wine is dark and rich with aromas of blackberries, raspberries, and other dark fruits. The smooth tannins and balanced acidity of the wine lends itself to pairing with charcuterie boards, grilled meats, and Mexican dishes.

Deschain Cellars — the convivial "little winery that could" — built out of 10 decommissioned shipping containers, is the passion project of Willem Johnson and Kristin Mapstone. It's the culmination of Willem's lifetime of experience and research in wine, hospitality and engineering. And, it has given Kristin a chance to exercise some offline creativity since so much of her time is spent sitting at a screen running an online marketing company. Willem and Kristin share a pioneering spirit and couldn't resist the opportunity to help build the North Texas Wine Country and support the revitalization of downtown Gainesville. When they found this beautiful fully wooded, undeveloped property so conveniently located off US-82, they knew the right time and the right place to start a new adventure had aligned.

Trebbiano "Texas High Plains", 2019

White: Dry (<1.0%)

A beautiful single-vineyard, single-block wine from the Texas High Plains. Silky on the tongue, our Texas High Plains Trebbiano is a perfect wine to sip all day. A pretty and flowered medium-bodied white that drinks side by side with some of the superb Verdicchio and fun-loving Soave!

"Unchained" Texas Red Wine, 2021

Red: Blends (<1.5%)

A Texas original. This wine should be called Unleashed. Rich notes of plum, barrel and ironwood in the nose, yielding dark blue fruit, cacao, and boysenberry on the palate. A smooth, structured & powerful wine with an unyielding finish.

Tempranillo/Malbec, 2021

Red: Bold (<1.5%)

One of the new stars of the Texas wine world, this classic Spanish varietal stands alongside its French friend Malbec to provide balance between spicy black cherry fruit, leathery tannins and nuances of baked earth. Full bodied, expansive mouth feel accompanied by hints of white pepper, baking spice and lightly toasted oak, this wine will linger in your thoughts.

"Siren's Song" Dessert Wine, 2021

White: Sweet (>1.5%)

Beautifully rose gold in color, laden with lush apricot and tangerine peel, this wine pairs with spice or salt. Wonderful as dessert all by itself, try this alongside your favorite spicy Thai dish, or as a perfect compliment to salty aged Grana Padano Parmigiano cheese.

Petals, 2019

White: Dry (<1.0%)

Notes of nectarine and/or apricot, floral. Full-bodied, dry, very drinkable

Peachy Keen, NV

White: Sweet (>1.5%)

Peachy like biting into a really ripe peach near the pit that drizzles down your chin on a hot summer day

Sunset Red, 2019

Red: Sweet (>1.5%)

Soft red blend with dark purple fruity notes - great chilled in the summer for sipping and with barbecue, tacos, pizza, and many of your favorite summer foods. In winter, hearty enough for stews and game meats as well as mulled wine and spicy Sangria

Tempranillo - Reserve, 2014

Red: Bold (<1.5%)

Traditional slightly acidic, dark cherry notes with a hint of French oak - nicely aged and smooth on the palate but great with steaks, hearty meats and to finish out the night

Flight, NV

Blush/Rosé

Sweet delicacy in a light Rosé. Flight by Kiepersol has the perfect level of sweetness for a refreshing experience highlighted by raspberries, strawberries, and a touch of crème brûlée. Sit back and enjoy the flight!

Vit, 2022

White: Off Dry (<1.5%)

Inspired by the Rieslings of Europe, the 2022 Vit caresses the palate with a perfect semi-sweetness. Fresh aromatics of lychee, pear, green apple, and orange blossom lead to a clean-cut palate of lemons and lemongrass. Serve chilled.

Merlot, 2017

Red: Medium (<1.5%)

Rich and refined, this Merlot holds a complex nose of dense brambleberries, violets, pine, and rosemary. The palate of açaí with a touch of anise brings earthiness and medium tannins characterize this special vintage.

Cabernet Sauvignon, 2018

Red: Bold (<1.5%)

Deeply mysterious with medium tannins that are artfully balanced. The nose of black cherry, cherry wood, dark plum, earthiness, and chocolate truffle cascades into a palate of generous blackberry notes. The 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon showcases the classic delicate style of Kiepersol while still respecting the robust depth of the varietal creating the most comfortable Cabernet you will ever experience.

Yellow Rose, NV

White: Sweet (>1.5%)

Orchard flavors of apple, peach, pear and apricot. This sweet white wine is an easy drinking favorite!

Tempranillo Reserve, 2019

Red: Medium (<1.5%)

Landon's 2019 Tempranillo features cherry, plum, tobacco, leather and herb flavors; a spicy, smooth mouthfeel leads to a round tannic finish. This wine is ruby red in color, you'll enjoy the balance between earth and fruit. This wine was named the Top Tempranillo in the world after winning Double Gold and Best in Class at the 2022 San Francisco International Wine Competition. (Forbes Magazine Oct. 2022)

Roussanne and Marsanne, 2022

White: Dry (<1.0%)

This medium-bodied white blend, grown in the Texas High Plains, emits aromas of Meyer lemon, beeswax, and apricot. Flavors of peach quince, and lemon zest lead to a dry crisp finish.

The Texan, 2021

Red: Bold (<1.5%)

A dry, full-bodied red wine that tips towards higher levels of mouth-watering acidity and tighter tannins. The rich flavors are both rustic and fruit-forward, with flavors of cherry, plum, and red currant, as well as smoky and earthy herbaceousness.

Prima Donna, 2021

White: Blends (<1.5%)

Drinks like Rousanne, Viognier, or a white Phone blend with traditional notes of peach, pear, mango, floral notes with beeswax, apricot, lemon and chamomile. The floral tones, honey, citrus, spices, stone fruits, and pome fruits all align, so while totally different grapes, each offers something unique

Pink Moscato, NV

White: Sweet (>1.5%)

Cold soaked, No oak. Drinks like Moscato, orange muscat, riesling, Gewürztraminer

Texican, 2020

Red: Blends (<1.5%)

Cold soaked whole grape clusters, pressed & fermented w/ skins. then aged in American and French oak for 18 months. Drinks like chianti or barolo, spicy merlots

Sweet Rodeo Red, NV

Red: Sweet (>1.5%)

Smooth, sweet red table wine that goes down as easy as cotton candy

Lost Oak's origin began in the 1950s when founder Gene Estes made wine in a bathtub in his native Abilene, Texas. You see, Abilene was a dry county that had no liquor stores so he had to seek creative diversion. It became a passion. After living and working in Alsace, France, crafting the art of winemaking, he founded Lost Oak Winery. Fortunately, his immersion in the wine industry connected the winery with Jim Evans, a remarkable Texas native winemaker, one of the best in the art, who now boasts over 40 vintages making Texas wine.

Viognier, 2022

White: Dry (<1.0%)

When swirled, this Viognier hugs the glass with its delicate honeysuckle color. It is bursting with aromas of white flowers, peach, sweet citrus, and a hint of minerality.

Mourvèdre Rosé, 2021

Blush/Rosé

True to its name, this rosé has tint that can only be described as rose petal pink. Aromas of ripe melons and tropical flowers mix with hints of white peach. This rosé explodes with flavors of raspberry, strawberry, and a zesty finish of lemon.

Dolce Rouge, 2022

Red: Sweet (>1.5%)

Dolce Rouge is big and wild from its almost purple hue to its smooth finish. Aromas of strawberry, brown sugar, and subtle spice are in abundance. It is full bodied and carries flavors of candied plum, dried fig, and a hint of blood orange on the finish.

Tribute Series Riesling, 2021

White: Off Dry (<1.5%)

A semi-sweet, medium-bodied white wine with notes of apple, citrus, and flowers. Its refreshing acidity is perfect for warm Texas days. This Tribute to Heritage honors Messina Hof's German history, and Riesling being the first wine made together by Paul V. and Paul M. Bonarrigo.

Angel, Late Harvest Riesling, NV

White: Sweet (>1.5%)

This crisp, sweet dessert wine was harvested from the last pick of Riesling grapes in the High Plains, and it is often described as apple pie in a glass. Names for its angelic sweetness and in honor of the stone angels carved in the Estate winery wall in Bryan.

GSM, 2021

Red: Light (<1.5%)

A dynamic red blend of Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre aged in hybrid American/French oak barrels for 12 months. This beautifully complex wine is extremely food-friendly and showcases notes of dark red fruit, soke, spice, and leather. A fanfavorite with all red wine lovers.

Artist Series Sangiovese, 2021

Red: Medium (<1.5%)

Messina Hof's Sangiovese is a medium-bodied, fruit-forward wine with smooth notes of tart cherries and plum. Vibrant acidity is complemented by earthy undertones and a hint of spice to create a flavor profile that pairs well with rich meat dishes and tomato-based pastas.

O'Farrell Country Vineyards

Small family winery that opened in 2011. They have been growing muscadines (14 varieties) since 2006. They also offer U-Pick.

Sweet Memories, 2021

Red: Sweet (>1.5%)

Black Noble muscadine varieties give this sweet red a floral, fruity taste, with just a hint of peppery notes.

Texas Treasure, 2019

Red: Blends (<1.5%)

Merlot grapes from Texas spent 18 months in French and American oak to make this mellow, full-bodied red. A touch of Noble muscadine gives it just a hint of fruitiness.

Moonglow, 2022

White: Sweet (>1.5%)

This highly aromatic sweet white is full of flavor and wonderfully representative of the floral, musky Carlos muscadines from which it's made.

Sassy Sisters, 2022

Blush/Rosé

This aromatic, sweet blush is a delicious, fruity combination of Carlos and Noble muscadines. Refreshing on a hot summer day, it pairs well with foods that bring a little spicy heat, such as barbecue and Thai.

Tempranillo, 2019

Red: Bold (<1.5%)

Rich tannins softened by aging in neutral barrels, big bold cherry flavors with dried fig and notes of tobacco, leather, and a touch of spice

Blanc du Bois, 2020

White: Dry (<1.0%)

Crisp citrus notes with vibrant aromas of lemon zest, grapefruit, and a hint of lime. There's a pleasant presence of tropical fruits, such as pineapple and ripe mango.

Two Steppin', NV

Red: Blends (<1.5%)

This blend of 75% Mourvèdre and 25% Tannat grapes has dominant notes of dark blackberry and black cherry. Hints of dried herbs, like thyme and sage, mingle with dark chocolate and a faint whisper of black pepper.

Bandit, NV

Red: Sweet (>1.5%)

Bourbon barrel red blend with dark notes of Bing cherry and subtle kiss of oak by aging in bourbon barrels, succulent notes of strawberry preserves

Cabernet Sauvignon, 2020

AROMA Fragrance c. from the grapes Fragrance of the wine that comes

ASTRINGENCY

Puckery feeling in the mouth caused by the tannins in red wines, which come from the grape skins that also give the wine its color

BALANCE

Harmonious combination of all the sensory elements of wine - fruit, acid, alcohol, nose, residual sugar (if any) and oak if barrels are used for fermentation and/or aging

The feeling of a wine's consistency, BODY or weight, in the mouth, usually associated with the alcohol content

BOUQUET Fragrance of the wine that comes from fermentation and aging

CLEAN Free of any off and/or unpleasant smells and flavors

CORKED

A musty, wet cardboard odor caused by a bad cork

CRISP Good, pleasant acidity

DRY The absence of sweetness

FINISH

The taste, smell and feeling in the mouth remaining after a wine is swallowed; a good wine usually has a nice, lingering finish

FRUITY Aromas and flavors of the grape (a wine can be fruity and still be dry)

HOT

A feeling of heat through the nasal passages and mouth when the alcohol content of a wine is too high and out of balance

NOSE wine

A Few Commonly Asked Questions

Q: Should I follow the rule to drink red wine with red meat and white wine with white meat?

No. Although some food and wine combinations are more compatible, you should serve what you enjoy and what tastes best to you and your guests.

Q: Why should wines be stored laying down?

To keep the corks wet and prevent air from getting into the bottle.

Q: Why are wineries starting to use screw caps and synthetic corks instead of real corks?

There is a worldwide problem now with tainted corks (from bacteria or chemical exposure) which cause wines to smell and taste "corked." A screw cap, although lacking the romance of a cork, is the most effective wine closure. Synthetic corks are effective but are often hard to put back into an opened bottle. For wine that needs several years of bottle aging to mature, a real cork is still the best method.

Q: Is room temperature the appropriate temperature to store and serve wine?

Room temperature is really cellar temperature which would be 55 to 60 degrees, not temperatures in the 70s or higher. Red and white wines are best served at cellar temperature, but you may chill white and rosé wines if you prefer. Champagne and sparkling wines should be served well-chilled.

Q: When tasting several wines, what is the best order in which to taste?

The general rule is: white wines before reds, dry white before sweeter white, light reds before heavy red and dessert wines last. It is easier for your palate to accept the flavors this way.

Q: Why do people swirl wine around in the glass before drinking? Does it have a purpose or just look good?

Swirling exposes wine to the air which helps release its aroma and bouquet. It also helps warm up a wine that is too cold.

Q: What are legs and do big legs mean a wine is good?

Legs are the tear-shaped drops that appear on the inside of the glass when you swirl wine around. They have to do with the alcohol in the wine and mean nothing by themselves. A good wine must have all the elements—fruit, acid, alcohol, tannin, oak (if barrels are used), etc.—and must have them in balance.

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
