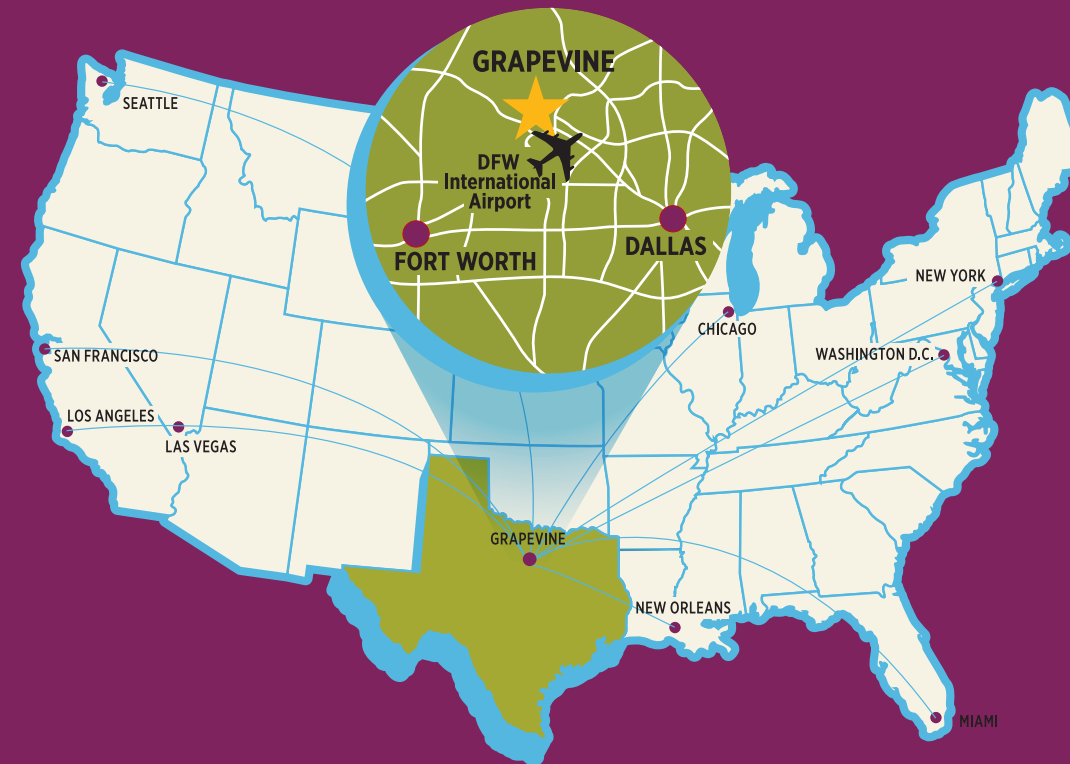

Dallas Fort Worth International Airport is located within Grapevine, and within 10 minutes of all Grapevine hotels.

GRAPEVINE HOTEL CHECK-IN—Grapevine has 20 hotels all within 10-minutes of DFW Airport, and most offer complimentary airport transportation.

DAY 2 - A DAY IN GRAPEVINE'S HISTORIC MAIN STREET DISTRICT

BREAKFAST DOWNTOWN—Enjoy a cup of coffee at one of Grapevine's many local Main Street cafés.

GRAPEVINE OBSERVATION TOWER—Take in the 360-degree view of the surrounding Grapevine area, including the skylines of both Dallas and Fort Worth, DFW Airport and beautiful Lake Grapevine, from 45-meters up.

GRAPEVINE FOOD TOURS—Enjoy a three-hour walking tour highlighting the history of Grapevine as well as a taste of some of Grapevine's local cuisine.

ART GALLERIES & WORKING ART STUDIOS—Explore the many galleries and art studios along Main Street, and possibly discover your own inner artist by creating your own art with a local artisan.

SETTLEMENT TO CITY MUSEUM—This collection of historic buildings tells the tale of how Grapevine went from a settlement in 1844, to the days as a farming community, to the thriving tourism destination it is today.

GRAPEVINE URBAN WINE TRAIL—Texas is the 5th largest producer of wine in the United States, known for bold reds and crisp white wines. Find your favorite Texas wine at one of the many winery tasting rooms.

DINNER & LIVE ENTERTAINMENT—The Historic Main Street District offers a wide variety of local restaurants and complimentary live music every evening, so enjoy!

DAY 3 - A STEP BACK IN TIME

A TEXAS-SIZE BREAKFAST—Enjoy breakfast at one of Grapevine's popular breakfast diners, including Old West Café, Main Street Bistro & Bakery, Waffle Way or Lone Star Café.

HISTORIC NASH FARM—Experience life on the Grapevine Prairie during the 19th century at this meticulously, preserved farmstead, still in operation today just as it was in the 1960s when first established.

GRAPEVINE VINTAGE RAILROAD—Embark on a nostalgic journey along the rails to the Historic Stockyards. Explore the western shops, saloons and museums... and don't miss the live cattle drive! *Grapevine Vintage Railroad operates on Saturdays & Sunday. **TEXRail offers transportation daily, also from Grapevine.

TEXAS STAR DINNER THEATER—Enjoy a comical, western, "who-dunnit" murder mystery and dinner show in the Historic Main Street District. *Friday & Saturday evenings only.
