

In 1859, Nash Farm was established when Thomas Jefferson Nash and his wife Elizabeth purchased 110 acres of farmland in Grapevine. Today, it's the oldest farmstead in Tarrant County exploring the life of Grapevine's earliest settlers.



The Farm raises heritage breeds of livestock, including sheep, turkeys and chickens, and also grows seasonal heirloom field crops year round. A variety of workshops and special events throughout the year, including the annual Barn Dance, Spring Into Nash, Fall Round-Up, Nash Farm Supper: A Farm-to-Fork Experience and more, offer guests unique learning experiences in a historic setting.




NOV 1 Victorian Gifts Workshop
