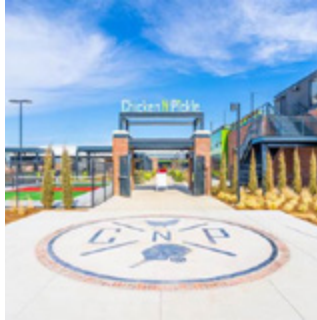

HERITAGE TRAIL

Take a walk through the past from **The Cotton Belt Depot to Settlement to City Museums!** See how the original settlers on the Grape Vine Prairie lived and worked. This collection of historic sites and museums highlights the cultural and family life of early Grapevine residents and explores how technology helped transform the prairie into the city we now enjoy.

COTTON BELT RAILROAD DEPOT

The 1888 Grapevine Cotton Belt Railroad Depot is one of Grapevine's most important buildings. It was operated by the St. Louis Southwestern Railway (also known as the Cotton Belt Route) until 1972, when the station was closed. Through the efforts of the Grapevine Garden Club, the Depot was saved from demolition and moved to Heritage Park at Ball and Wall Streets, where it remained for 20 years. In 1972, the Grapevine Historical Society was organized to utilize the Depot building for a new museum to preserve Grapevine's unique history and heritage. Twenty years later, the Depot moved back to Main Street. The Depot has Conductor and Porter uniforms on display and now plays host to the ticketing site of the Grapevine Vintage Railroad and a gift shop. It is open to visitors Friday-Sunday. 701 S. Main St.

Located in the historic Grapevine rail yard area, the enormous burgundy and silver baggage car is on static display behind the #771 Baldwin Mikado 2-8-2 steam engine.

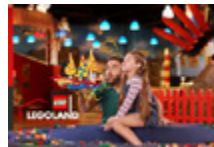
