THE WOULD-BE TRAIN ROBBERS

To see the much-talked-about Would-Be Train Robbers in Grapevine, you have to look up—about 75 feet high, to be exact, to the Grapevine Glockenspiel on the corner of Main and Hudgins streets. The Glockenspiel tells the tale of Would-Be Train Robbers Nat Barrett and Willy Majors. It's 1890 and both characters have come to Grapevine to rob the train. When they meet up in the saloon and discover they both have the same plan, a gunfight ensues. What Nat and Willy learn is that crime doesn't pay. Each day at 10 a.m., Noon, 2 p.m., 4 p.m., 6 p.m. and 8 p.m., these two characters emerge from the Glockenspiel tower to perform.

HERITAGE TRAIL

Take a walk through the past from The **Cotton Belt Depot to Settlement to City Museums!** See how the original settlers on the Grape Vine Prairie lived and worked. This collection of historic sites and museums highlights the cultural and family life of early Grapevine residents and explores how technology helped transform the prairie into the city we now enjoy.

GRAPEVINE HISTORICAL MUSEUM

The museum is located in the Ted R. Ware Plaza Settlement to City museum complex and housed in the Grapevine Ice Company building at 206 West Hudgins Street, just off Main Street in Grapevine, Texas.

The front exterior of the museum replicates the appearance of the Grapevine Ice Company building originally built in 1940. The Ice House was an important and thriving business in Grapevine's development into the 1970s. The Grapevine Historical Museum is provided by the Grapevine Historical Society to preserve the history of the Grapevine area. A visit to the Grapevine Historical Museum offers many interesting and valuable artifacts related to life on the Grape Vine Prairie.

Visitors will enjoy the many artifacts and knowledge about times in history and the spirit of the people of Grapevine.

GRAPEVINE PUBLIC ART TRAIL

Benjamin Richard Wall
Corner of Wall St. and Main St.

Standing in front of City Hall is a life size tribute to a gentleman from Grapevine's history. Benjamin Richard (B.R.) Wall was the 4th Mayor of Grapevine who served alternately as either mayor or city council member from 1912 to 1946. The statue was created by Archie St. Claire and dedicated in May 2004.

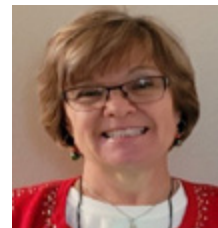
