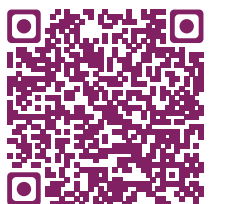

RIDE THE RAILS

Texas has more trains than you might think and taking one to visit Grapevine is a breeze! There are almost 20 Amtrak stations serving the Great State of Texas. The Texas Eagle and Heartland Flyer routes bring passengers to Fort Worth, where they can take the new Trinity Metro TEXRail commuter train Eastbound to Grapevine Main Station. Trains operate nearly 24 hours a day and at higher frequency during morning and evening commutes. Amenities include a designated quiet car, level boarding, bike racks, USB charging stations, seatback trays, Free WiFi and overhead luggage storage.



FARMERS AND ARTISANS MARKETS

Come join us at the seasonal, outdoor Grapevine Farmers & Artisan Market, located at the Town Square Gazebo (325 S. Main St.). The market offers fresh Texas produce, baked goods, and handcrafted and Texas-made items. The market operates Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. through September 11, 2021 and features musical artists performing on the Gazebo stage from Noon until 3 p.m. Produce and prepared foods are also available at Grapevine's year round indoor farmers market, located at 520 S. 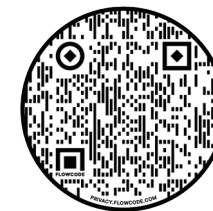


DOWN ON MAIN STREET
