HERITAGE TRAIL

Take a walk through the past from The Cotton Belt Depot to Settlement to City Museums! See how the original settlers on the Grape Vine Prairie lived and worked. This collection of historic sites and museums highlights the cultural and family life of early Grapevine residents and explores how technology helped transform the prairie into the city we now enjoy.

Museums are open Saturdays and Sundays from 10 a.m.-4p.m. Located at 206 W. Hudgins St.

SECTION FOREMAN HOUSE

The Section Foreman House was built in the 1890s to house railroad workers and store maintenance equipment. By the 1970s, section houses were being slowly phased out and the Cotton Belt Railway deemed the Grapevine Section Foreman House unnecessary. But the old house was not ready to die. The structure was moved to 3036 Hall Johnson Road in south Grapevine and was used as a residence until 1990. On June 7, 1991, the Grapevine Heritage Foundation purchased the house and on January 12, 1993, 300 S. Main St. it was moved back to its original location near the Cotton Belt rail-



road tracks. Today it is part of the self-guided walking tour of the Cotton Railroad District Historic and is used for special events.
