Bingham Family Vineyards is rooted in the High Plains of Texas. The Bingham family produces 100% Texas grown and crafted estate wines. In 1901, the Bingham family moved to Terry County, Texas. Future Bingham generations settled and learned organic farming and winemaking. Bingham continued to earn accolades, including winning awards for all four wines entered (from over 350 unique wine entries) at the 41st Annual Lone Star International Wine Competition. GRAPEVINE OBSERVATION TOWER



The Grapevine Observation Tower is open year-round, and from February 12 – 16, come visit during the Valentine's Day promotion. Your \$10 ticket per couple includes a trip up 150' in the Tower (where you'll see breathtaking points of interest in Grapevine and the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex) a photo op and a Valentine's memento. Purchase walk-up tickets at the Visitor Information Center or online at GrapevineTexasUSA.com. *Private group tours may be arranged seven days in advance.*

GRAPEVINE PUBLIC ART TRAIL

Puffy Leaving the Station – Engine 2248 (known as Puffy) was built in 1896 at the Cooke Locomotive Works. She was originally purchased for passenger and freight service in California, and was later converted into a fire train, then used as a ceremonial engine. She made her first trek to Grapevine in 1993, and although she is not currently in service, this mural by Lynn Arts of Puffy Leaving the Station is a hallmark of Grapevine Main Station, greeting guests as they arrive. 815 S.
