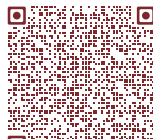

GRAPEVINE PUBLIC ART TRAIL

Coming Home is a two-piece bronze sculpture created by artist Michael Pavlovsky and dedicated on Memorial Day, 2000, depicts a soldier returning from service in the military to a loving embrace. The arch bears symbols of the five military branches and various faiths. The location also pays homage to the railroad that many soldiers departed for and later returned from service. 705 S.
