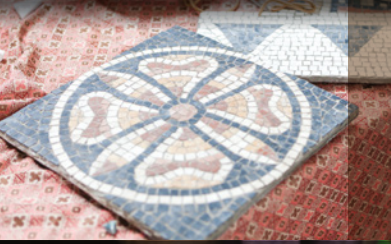


History Hunt!

Rediscover Roman Chichester



Follow the map (overleaf) to find the Roman sites in Chichester City Centre. Can you answer all the questions below? Write down your answers and submit the completed form to the Novium Museum, Tower Street, Chichester, PO19 1QH, to be in with a chance to win a Roman workshop or loan box for your entire class.



Go to the First Floor of the Novium Museum.

1. Find the Roman gravestone. Can you find who it belonged to? What was her name?

Leave the museum and turn right towards the city walls. Go up the stairs to the Walls walk.

2. Find the city walls panel on the North Walls walk.
Using the timeline, can you find when the walls were built?

Continue along the walls until you reach Leaders estate agents.

3. Find the brass plaque about the North Gate. Where did the Roman road go to?

Head down North Street towards the city centre.

4. Go to the Assembly Rooms. Find the stone on the front of the building.
Which two Gods was the temple dedicated to?

Walk towards the Market Cross.

5. Can you spot the red flags on the side of the buildings? What colour are the animals?

Head down East Street and turn left at Little London.

6. Find the mosaic on the wall in Little London Mews. What type of building is it from?

Continue down Little London, turn right onto East Row, then right onto East Walls.

7. Find the brass plaque about the East Gate. What did the Romans call the market town of Chichester?

Walk back down East Street towards the Cathedral.

8. Find the mosaic at the back of the Cathedral. Which 3 stones make up the small tiles?

Head back to the Novium Museum.

9. Find the Jupiter stone on the ground floor. When was this found?
