Staff Updates

Trans Am Nationals 2022

- This year's event was a huge success. We provided over 67 signs designed by Larry- the group auctioned those signs bringing in \$2,500 for the make a wish foundation.
- A record 520 cars were registered and 3,500 attendees.
- o Trans Am Nationals committee donated \$20,000 to the local make a wish foundation.
- o The event generated 600+ room nights in Greene County.
- The economic impact of this event combined with the Cruise-In at the mall was \$3.3 million dollars and supported over 1,500 jobs.
- o The mall is planning to do their event next year.
- o The Nutter Center is working with the event planners to provide parking for the trailers.

Sports Events and Updates

- The Air Force Marathon and Health Expo was successful after a two-year hiatus.
- The event was well attended with 10,000 registered participants.
- The CVB had a booth set up at the Health Expo at the Nutter Center where we offered out Visitors Guides and other information.
- Kevin is working on initiatives with the CORA Expo, Team Ohio State Association, and collaboration with Greene County Parks.
- Kevin is also continuing to work with Winter Guard International.
