Lodging Revenue

- Second Quarter is up 18.07%, with a few payments missing.
- Third quarter is down 4.6%, several payments are missing.

Restructuring

- The staff has absorbed Allen's responsibilities since he has resigned.

Staff Updates

Trans Am Nationals Wrap-Up

- The Cruise-In was a great success.
- There were ten food trucks and several vendors catering to the attendees.
- The band Stranger provided entertainment with a fantastic selection of 80's music.
- There was a lineup of 505 cars drawing in over 3,000 attendees at the Holiday Inn.
- 1,500 room nights were booked county-wide.
- Trans Am Nationals donated \$20,000 to the local Special Wish Foundation.

• The Trans Am Nationals stands as one of our region's largest and most impactful car shows. The car show itself and the associated cruise-in that extended into Tipp City collectively generated an estimated \$5 million in economic activity.

Air Force Marathon & Cycle Con

- The Air Force Marathon Expo took place at the Nutter Center and turned out great.
- The CVB booth was located on the floor level this year, which was great.
- Wendy and Chris from the Beavercreek Chamber helped work the booth.
- The marathon itself went great.
- Kevin will meet with event planners in a week to go over how we can better work with them moving forward.
- Kevin is still waiting on feedback from the event to get the actual economic impact numbers.
- Cycle Con was held on the same weekend as the Air Force Marathon.
- Cycle Con is a biking convention held throughout the United States and moves every two
 years, bringing in thousands of guests worldwide.
- They meet annually for two reasons: to buy and sell equipment and to engage in fraternal activities.
- This is their second year in our region. Last year, they were in Dayton and moved to Xenia this year.
- Typically, the event will move next year, but they are considering a return to the fairgrounds next year.
- Attendance was higher than expected, and guests really enjoyed the trails and how accommodating the community was for cycling.
- Kevin was very busy with both events but did a great job.

- We had a full-page ad in Compass Ohio Magazine and a full-page digital ad on their website promoting Clifton Mill.
- To date, the digital ad has sent over 800 clicks to our website.
