#### **Lodging Revenue**

- Third Ouarter is up 16.53%.
- o Fourth Quarter is up 17.23%

### **Advertising & Visitors Guide**

- Larry has been working on a redesign of our Visitors Guide and new graphics for some of the inside pages.
- o Everyone has been working on updating listings inside the Visitors Guide.
- o Larry created two full-page ads for Compass Ohio Magazine.

- Larry created new pins for Hamvention and keychains for Trans Am Nationals and Hamvention.
- o He also helped design the Xenia Chamber's Annual Awards Dinner invitations.

#### **Travel & Tourism Research Numbers**

- Prior to the pandemic, Travel and Tourism accounted for 1 in 4 new jobs worldwide, 10.3% of all jobs (333 million), and 10.3% of global GDP (9.6 trillion).
- o International visitor spending amounted to \$1.8 trillion in 2019.
- Following a loss of almost 4.9 trillion in 2020, travel and tourism's contribution to GDP increased by \$1 trillion in 2021.
- o In 2020, 62 million jobs were lost, a drop of 18.6%. 18.2 million jobs were recovered in 2021, representing an increase of 6.7% year-on-year.
- Following a decrease of 47.4% in 2020, domestic visitor spending increased by 31.4% in 2021.

- Following a decrease of 69.7% in 2020, international visitor spending rose by 3.8% in 2021.
- Numbers are not in yet for 2022 but are expected to increase dramatically.
