Old Business

Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-09 (2026 City of Greenburg Budget) on second reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Roll call vote, Jamie Cain – yes, Mark Carman – no, Kevin Fleetwood – yes, Rodney King – yes, Vietta McKenzie – yes, Darrel Poling – yes, Daryl Tressler – yes. Motion passes 6-1.

Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-10 (2026 Greensburg School Corporation Budget) on second reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Rodney King. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-11 (2026 Elected Officials Salary) on second reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Roll call vote, Jamie Cain – yes, Mark Carman – no, Kevin Fleetwood – yes, Rodney King – yes, Vietta McKenzie – yes, Darrel Poling – yes, Daryl Tressler – yes. Motion passes 6-1.

Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-12 (2026 City Employee Salary) on second reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-13 (2026 City Utilities Salary) on second reading with the choice of the previously approved salaries made by Rodney King, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-14 (Additional Appropriations for Airport and General Fund) made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Darrell Poling. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

New Business

Building Commissioner Sarah Hamer presented Ordinance 2025-15 amending Ordinance 2020-7 for mowing fees. Council members voiced concerns over it being every one year, suggesting that it be a three-year cycle for repeat offenders. Hamer reported 54 work orders this year, 6 or 7 repeat offenders in those orders. Total work hours is 188.5, equaling \$16,781.90. The effective date was questioned and suggested January 1 be put in the document. Motion to pass on first reading with amendments to the timeframe made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Rodney King. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Director of Public Projects Zach Wirrig gave an update on City projects.

Mayor Marsh presented the 2026 Public Meeting Schedule. Motion to approve the public meeting schedule as presented made by Mark Carman, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Mayor Marsh also presented the 2026 City Holiday Schedule, following the State of Indiana's schedule. Motion to approve the 2026 City Holiday Schedule made by Vietta McKenzie, seconded by Mark Carman. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Reminder that next month's meeting will be Wednesday, November 12, due to Veteran's Day on Tuesday, November 11.

Council members gave updates on their respective boards and commissions.
