<u>Veterans Way Phase II Update</u> —The ribbon cutting ceremony was held on October 21. The work is still on-going. There is a possibility the road will be open to traffic tomorrow. Everything is complete with the exception of some some work needed on the streetlights. The traffic signal at S.R. 3 still needs some work.

<u>Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan</u> – Our consultant has produced a final draft and it has been reviewed by staff and is almost ready to be released to the Steering Committee. It should be ready to submit to the City Planning Commission by the end of the year.

<u>Veterans Way Residential Project</u> — There is continuing to be work on an agreement. The committee has read it and commented, and there has been further revision. It has come to the point where the agreement can be sent to the potential developer for their consideration and comment. The process is moving forward and is very close to a conclusion.
