Tax Abatement #2018-13

The issue discussed was the possible revocation of Resolution 2018-13, a tax abatement granted to Mr. Whitaker in 2018 for a building he constructed. At the time the abatement was granted, the plan for the building was to house medical arts. Currently, the building houses an office for Mr. Whitaker's business as well as a liquor store.

Pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-12.1-3, tax abatement for the development or rehabilitation of real property may not be approved for several types of facilities, including a package liquor store. This was the issue discussed during the meeting.

Both legal counsels offered their perspectives on the matter. Councilors had the opportunity to ask questions and Mr. Whitaker had the opportunity to make his case as well.

A resolution for continuation or revocation will be addressed at the next meeting on November 1, 2021.

Motion to close the public meeting made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Rick Emsweller. Voice vote all ayes no nays. Motion passed.
