Today is Wednesday, November 12, 2025, and the time being 6:30 pm. The meeting of the Greensburg City Council has been called to order.

Approval of Minutes

Minutes from October 14 approved as presented.

Old Business

Mayor Marsh presented Ordinance 2025-15 Amending Ordinance 2020-7 Mowing Fees for second reading. The specification of a three-year cycle was added into the language. Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-15 on second reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

New Business

Greg Fox of Dunn & Associates (the City's health insurance provider) gave a presentation on the state of the City's insurance for the past three years and the upcoming year. No action was taken by the Council. This was for informational purposes only.

Director of Public Projects Zach Wirrig presented Resolution 2025-15 for EDA and Allocation Area Additions and Revisions. This resolution adjusts allocation areas within city limits. It has already been approved and passed by the Redevelopment Commission, as well as the Plan Commission. Motion to support and approve the RDC's Resolution 2025-15 as presented made by Kevin Fleetwood, seconded by Darrell Poling. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Mayor Joshua Marsh presented a letter from Wastewater Superintendent Joe Cain stating that the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) has determined that the Greensburg Wastewater

Treatment Plant (WWTP) no longer needs to develop a Combine Sewer Overflow (CSO) plan, and that no further Long-Term Control Plan (LTCP) action needs to be taken at this time. The elimination of this requirement will result in several million dollars in savings for the community, based on what other communities have spent on similar projects. The WWTP staff have worked diligently to make this happen.

Council members gave updates on their respective boards and commissions.
