Borns also presented Ordinance 2023-24 to Update Ordinance 2023-20 for City Employee Salaries for second reading. Motion to approve Ordinance 2023-24 on second reading made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

New Business

The monthly update from the Veridus Group on the Municipal Complex Project was presented by Mayor Joshua Marsh. This past month has seen a lot of progress. Project remains on budget and schedule.

Ron May, City Engineer, presented Ordinance 2023-28 for Vacation of Alley on KOVA properties. Motion to approve Ordinance 2023-28 on first reading made by Kevin Fleetwood, seconded by Rick Emsweller. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Motion to suspend the rules on Ordinance 2023-28 made by Kevin Fleetwood, seconded by Darrell Poling. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Motion to approve Ordinance 2023-28 on second reading made by Kevin Fleetwood, seconded by Rick Emsweller. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Wastewater Superintendent Zeke Smith presented a local limits update. Kevin Earnest from Strand Associates was present to help discuss the local limits update. Every five years this needs to be completed. They are submitting a letter to the EPA with their findings, analysis, and suggested new limits on metals that are discharged by local industries. Once that is submitted, they will bring an ordinance next month to the Board and Council with the updated limits. Tonight's presentation was for the Council's information only. No action needs to be taken presently.

Mayor Joshua Marsh presented Ordinance 2023-29 which replaces Ordinance 2023-13 for the Creation of Designated Outdoor Refreshment Area (DORA). The original Ordinance (2023-13) was sent into the state with the DORA application and suggestions were made to make the ordinance and creation of the area complete and more specific. This ordinance has implemented those suggestions. Motion to approve Ordinance 2023-29 on first reading made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Vietta McKenzie. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Motion to approve Ordinance 2023-29 on second reading made by Vietta McKenzie, seconded by Rick Emsweller. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.
