Jamie Cain began discussion on the new fitness park shade cover. It was tabled from last meeting. Chief Nathan Stoermer asked to offer a conditional offer to candidate number 3 after finding out one of his firefighters will be moving on to another location. Motion to approve a conditional offer of employment to candidate number 3, pending his approval from passing all exams, made by Glenn Tebbe, seconded by Rodney King. City Attorney Chris Stephen and City Engineer Ron May opened the bids for the Community Crossings Match Grant. First grant read was from Globe Asphalt and Paving Company for a bid of \$1,266,872.30. Second bid opened was from Dave O'Mara Contractor Inc. for \$1,144,700.00. Next was a bid from All Star Paving Inc. for \$1,574,978.03. The final bid was from Paul H. Rohe Company for a total of \$1,498,359.05. The engineer's estimate for the project was \$1,302,739.06. Engineer May recommended to the Board to award the contract to Dave O'Mara conditionally on further inspection of the mathematics by himself and the Street Commissioner. Motion to award the contract to the lowest conforming bid by Rodney King, seconded by Glenn Tebbe. Jamie Cain – yes, Rodney King – yes, Glenn Tebbe – yes, Mayor Marsh – yes. Motion passes.

Clerk Treasurer Amy Borns presented the claims as well as an additional bill that did not make it onto the docket, which was a monthly bill from Comcast that has been approved in months prior.
