Minutes

Minutes from the December 9, 2025, meeting were approved as presented.

Old Business

Wastewater Superintendent Joe Cain presented Ordinance 2025-20 to amend Ordinance 2010-16 for second reading. Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-20 on second reading made by Rodney King, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Clerk Treasurer Amy Borns presented Ordinance 2025-19 to amend Ordinance 2025-12 2026 City Salary Ordinance for second reading. The only change is to the Airport Manager pay rate range. Motion to approve Ordinance 2025-19 on second reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

New Business

Clerk Treasurer Amy Borns presented an updated list of encumbrances to the Council. Several more items were added that were received after the December meeting. Encumbering the funds will help ease the burden on next year's budget. Motion to approve the encumbrances as presented made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Rodney King. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Borns also presented a list of outstanding checks from 2023. This process is done on an annual basis to clear checks that are still outstanding on bank reconciliations. The checks will be reversed, and a list will be kept on

file with information on vendor and total. Motion to approve the list of uncleared checks as presented made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Mark Carman. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Mayor Joshua Marsh presented the lease agreement with Decatur County Solid Waste. Solid Waste will lease the old Street Department building from the City and run a full-time recycling center. This is an agreement for ten years. Motion to approve the contract made by Mark Carman, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

The Council held elections for City Council President. Rodney King made a motion to nominate Jamie Cain, seconded by Darrell Poling. Council Member Cain accepted the nomination. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Council members gave updates on their respective boards and commissions.

Police Chief Mike McNealy and Mayor Joshua Marsh administered the swearing in of Officer Lucas Schmidt.

Before adjourning, President Jamie Cain addressed the Council about the data center and the lawful steps the Council has already taken for this project. There are currently no decisions to be made on the matter, therefore no discussion is needed on the matter.
