### **Pledge of Allegiance**

### **Election of Officers**

Nomination of Jamie Cain for Council President made by Kevin Fleetwood, seconded by Vietta McKenzie. No other nominations were presented. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Jamie Cain is elected President of the City Council.

### **Approve Minutes**

Mayor Marsh presented minutes from the public hearing and regular meeting on December 12, 2023. Minutes were approved as presented.

### **New Business**

Matt Mason presented an update on the Municipal Complex project. The brick is going up on the fire department and the framing is going up on the inside. For the street department, most of the inside is prepared for the new walls. Project remains on budget and on schedule to be completed in the spring of 2024.

Whitney Kelling Manager of Municipal Programs with ARa was present to introduce herself as a grant writer for the City. She gave a little bit of her background, what she currently does with ARa, and what she can do to assist the City with any grants or grant writing needs.

Mayor Marsh requested that the Daily News be accepted as the official newspaper for the City. The Council agreed to accepting this request.

Resolution 2024-02 was presented. This resolution is to amend the City's ADA Transition Plan to name Zach Wirrig as ADA Plan coordinator instead of Ron May. Motion to approve Resolution 2024-02 made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Resolution 2024-03 was presented. This resolution is similar to the previous one in that it is replacing Zach Wirrig for Ron May, but this one is for the Title XI Plan. Motion to approve Resolution 2024-03 made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Darrell Poling. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Ordinance 2024-01 to Amend all Code of Ordinances that Reference the City Engineer was presented This ordinance is a more streamlined way to state that for all City ordinances the title of City Engineer is interchangeable with the title of Director of Municipal Projects. Motion to approve Ordinance 2024-01 on first reading made by Vietta McKenzie, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Motion to suspend the rules on Ordinance 2024-01 made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Motion to approve Ordinance 2024-01 for second reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Vietta McKenzie. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Street Commissioner Mark Klosterkemper discussed Community Crossings Grant Matching. The City won the CCMG for 2023 but the timing of the award came too late to either put the amount in the budget or lock a contract to encumber the funds. Klosterkemper informed the Council that next month he will be bringing an additional appropriation for a contract on bids that will opened early February. The CCMG money that was awarded last year is what he will be requesting for the additional appropriation.

Council Members gave monthly updates on the boards on which they are each members.

Fire Chief Nate Stoermer and Police Chief Mike McNealy gave an update on the preparedness for the 2024 Eclipse.

Mayor Marsh recognized City Engineer Ron May for his almost 10 years of service to the City. He also invited the public to May's retirement open house on January 22 from 10 am to noon in the multipurpose room at City Hall.

Mayor Marsh also recognized outgoing Council member Rick Emsweller for his years of service on the City Council.
