New Business

Clerk Treasurer Amy Borns presented Resolution 2026-02 Transfer of Funds. The bonds for the 2007 water and wastewater bonds were paid off in 2022. Since that time, that bank account (Bank 30) has not received any funds since 2022, with the exception of the interest on the leftover funds in that account. The money leftover is technically property of the Redevelopment Commission (RDC). Borns requested that Bank 30 be closed and the funds leftover in that account be moved to Bank 28. This has been previously approved by the RDC as well. Motion to approve the transfer of funds and closing of Bank 30 made by Daryl Tressler, seconded by Rodney King. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Public Projects Director Zach Wirrig presented Resolution 2026-01 for Downtown Build Operate Transfer. This is for a project downtown that will be funded with READI funds. It will focus on a few alley way and sidewalk improvements. Motion to approve Resolution 2026-01 made by Kevin Fleetwood, seconded by Vietta McKenzie. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Director Wirrig also presented a transfer of property at 919 N Lincoln Street. The City purchased this property during the Lincoln Street project. The adjoining property owner to the south has maintained the property. The person purchasing the property wants to know if the city would be interested in transferring the property to the new owners as part of the entire property. The person purchasing the property contracted out a survey. The property committee met and agreed with the transfer. The adjoining property owner is looking to rebuild the retaining wall and improve aesthetics. The parcel has no real future use. Combining it with the adjoining property makes it more useful. The person requesting the transfer covered all expenses. Motion to

approve transfer made by Vietta McKenzie, seconded by Mark Carman. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Mayor Marsh spoke on behalf of Bill Rethlake who wanted to be able to commend the Police Department on their work at former Police Chief Keith Gay's funeral. Mr. Rethlake was impressed with their honor guard and service during the ceremony. Multiple community members have also shared this sentiment with the Mayor. GPD was thanked for their work.

Each council member gave an update on their respective boards or commissions.

Motion to adjourn made by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes. Meeting adjourned at 6:53 PM.
