Mike McNealy, Police Chief, presented the retirement of Detective Stephen Barnes. Chief McNealy read a list of accomplishments of Detective Barnes and discussed the retirement payout for him. Detective Barnes was thanked for his years of service to the City.

Chief McNealy presented an update on the HVAC project. The Board of Works approved the bid that came in last month from Koch Mechanical, with the stipulation that the Council supports the finances and the additional appropriation to fund the project.

Ron May, City Engineer, presented Ordinance 2023-03 to amend intersection control of Barachel and Lincoln, removing a turn light and installing a yield sign.
