The Mayor acknowledged Utilities Manager Donna Lecher for her 33 years of service to the City. He reminded everyone of her retirement open house on her final day of March 31 from 11:30 am – 2:00 pm in the Multipurpose Room.

Street Commissioner Mark Klosterkemper gave a brief update on the construction being conducted by INDOT on US 421. This construction is to replace seven structures.
