



## CITY COUNCIL MEETING

### Pledge of Allegiance

Today is Tuesday, April 14, 2026, and the time being 6:30 pm. The meeting of the Greensburg City Council has been called to order.

### Approval of Minutes

Minutes from the March 10 public hearing and regular meeting were approved as presented.

### New Business

Cheryl Franks from the Lochmueller Group was present to discuss the Safe Streets 4 All: Future SR3 Highway Safety Action Plan. The plan is to reduce fatal accidents on State Road 3 and improve safety. She covered lots of options and possible projects that the City could implement in the future to help with the safety plan. No action is taken at this time by the Council.

Clerk Treasurer Amy Borns presented Resolution 2026-03 Amending Resolution 2025-18 for transfers between funds. There was a correction that needed to be made and less money transferred between funds than was originally approved. Motion to approve Resolution 2026-03 made by Daryl Tressler, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Borns presented Resolution 2026-07 Transfer of Funds and Closure of Banks. There are three current banks with funds that have been inactive or are no longer necessary. These funds will be moved as presented on the resolution, and the banks will be closed. Motion to approve Resolution 2026-07 made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Mark Carman. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Borns presented Resolution 2026-08 Declaring Dormant Funds. These three funds have had no activity for several years and do not seem to need to stay active. The resolution proposes moving any remaining funds into the General Fund. Motion to approve Resolution 2026-08 made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Building Commissioner Sarah Hamer presented Ordinance 2026-02 Rezoning for 310 E Fourth Street on first reading. The plan is for the owner to rezone the property to build market rate townhomes. Motion to approve Ordinance 2026-02 on first reading made by Mark Carman, seconded by Jamie Cain. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Director of Public Projects Zach Wirrig presented Resolution 2026-04 ADA Sidewalk BOT Agreement. This agreement is with O'Mara Construction with the intent of putting sidewalks where there currently are no sidewalks. There is very little design work needed, which is the reasoning for going with the BOT option. The intended streets for the sidewalks are Carver and Fourth and possibly Moscow Road, Fourth Street from Lincoln to Carver, and Carver from 6th on the north side of North Park all the way to Veterans Way. Motion to approve Resolution 2026-04 made by Vietta McKenzie, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Wirrig presented Resolution 2026-05 Greensburg Municipal Building BOT Agreement to raise the roofline to be able to fit an aerial apparatus at Fire Station 2 and reroof the police department building. The goal is to do this project inside the scope of the amount of money that was received from the sale of the old fire station. Motion to approve Resolution 2026-05 made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Mark Carman. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Wirrig presented Resolution 2026-06 Municipal Wastewater Clarifier BOT Agreement. The scope of this project is to replace the two existing clarifiers at the wastewater treatment plant. The current clarifiers were installed in the 1980's. The main concrete structure in which the clarifiers stand will be reused to lower overall cost. Motion to approve Resolution 2026-06 made by Rodney King, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

In addition to the BOT for Resolution 2026-06 is a contract with the company Thieneman, who will be doing the work. Motion to approve the scoping agreement with Thieneman made by Rodney King, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Wirrig presented the sale agreement for the city parcel at 128 W Railroad Street. It has already been approved by the RDC. No vote is necessary since it was already approved last year. This is just the final paperwork to be signed by the Mayor.

Mayor Marsh presented the interlocal agreement for emergency communications department with the County. The current agreement expired approximately two years ago. The new agreement would create two bodies: one to oversee policy and operations, and the other to be the fiscal oversight committee. The agreement will run from May 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027. Motion to approve the agreement made by Darrell Poling, seconded by Vietta McKenzie. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Council members gave updates on their respective boards and commissions.

Director of Public Projects Zach Wirrig gave updates on local projects.

Street Commissioner Mark Klosterkemper advised the Council that he submitted an unofficial detour to INDOT for the I74 construction. If approved, it would allow the City and County to be reimbursed for any damages done to the detour during the construction process. The initial submission was denied. However, seeing that the City and County have made over \$900,000 in improvements in just the last year to this specific route, Klosterkemper, along with the County, would like support in appealing INDOT's decision. The Council fully supports Klosterkemper in this endeavor.

Motion to adjourn made by Darrell Poling. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes. Meeting adjourned at 7:44 PM.
