# City of Greensburg Redevelopment Commission Regular Meeting Monday, April 7, 2022 7:00 p.m. City Hall 314 W. Washington Street

President Dr. David Weigel called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Roll Call - Board members present were: Dr. David Weigel, Ken Dornich, Darren Burkhart, Darrell Poling, and Jamie Humpert. Ex-Officio Mark Bower was absent. City Attorney Chris Stephen, Street Commissioner Mark Klosterkemper, City Engineer Ron May and City Clerk Treasurer Amy Borns were also present. Judy Curd performed the duties of secretary.

Agenda – The agenda was approved as presented.

Minutes – Dr. Weigel presented the March 3, 2022 regular meeting minutes for approval. They were approved as presented. The March 29, 2022 Special Meeting minutes and the March 29, 2022 Executive Session meeting minutes were also presented by Dr. Weigel for approval. They were approved as presented.

# **NEW BUSINESS**

# Amy Borns, City Clerk/Treasurer

Amy Borns gave a presentation regarding the financial reports generated by the new bookkeeping system recently installed by the City of Greensburg Clerk/Treasurer's Office.

# Ron May, City Engineer

Remaining Property for Sale - There are two remaining parcels that will be offered for sale. You offer the parcels for sale and if there are no bids received, then if someone else comes along you may negotiate with them for a fair value. Ron suggested that the board offer the last two parcels for sale now. Thus that step in the process would be behind you. And, if someone would come along expressing interest then you could sit down with them and negotiate on those two remaining parcels. The appraisals are current. One of the two is a little older than the other one, so now might be a good time to go ahead and make that offer for public bid and get that part of the process out of the way. One appraisal was done in September 2021 and the other done in January 2022.

Dr. Weigel asked if we wait too much longer, would we need to get it re-appraised.

City Attorney Chris Stephen noted that based on what he has read, he has not been able to find any set period identified in the statute. However, the longer you wait, the more likely you will have to do a new appraisal. It does not appear to have any kind of book ends other than you do have to have a current appraisal.

Ron stated that you need to ask any reasonable amount above the appraised value. He will forward the appraisals to the board for review. Chris recommended that the board discuss this before the next board meeting. We are setting June as a target date for bid. No action is needed tonight. It will be put on next month's agenda.

# Veteran's Way Residential Project

Ron May stated that the project has seen some movement in the past month. Chris Stephen added that we have now moved past the phase where the property was sent to bid. So we are at the phase where we can sign off and start the project. There are still some small details that need to be resolved. The potential developer did not have any problems with the terms presented so far. We may move forward with the authorization. The agreement should come before the commission for signature in May.
