Pledge of Allegiance

Today is Tuesday, June 11, 2024, and the time being 5:30 pm. The meeting of the Greensburg City Council is called to order. At this time, please silence all electronic devices.

Approval of Minutes

Minutes for the regular meeting on May 14 and the executive session on May 15 were approved as presented.

Old Business

Director of Public Projects Zach Wirrig presented Ordinance 2024-10 Amendment to Street and Alley Vacation Fee, including the update about the cost the Council requested last month. Motion to approve Ordinance 2024-10 made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Daryl Tressler. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

New Business

John Bryant of the Veridus Group gave a monthly update on the Municipal Complex Project. The Street Department is mostly complete. They are only waiting for fiber to be installed for the fire alarm. The Fire Department is coming along with a hold-up on the installation of the elevator. Toby Holcomb with Meyer Najem was present to discuss the completion of the project and delays in the schedule. The project is expected to be completed in mid-July.

Bryan Robbins, EDC Director, presented the approval of CF-1's for tax abatements. The tax abatement committee recommended approval of all CF-1's that were submitted. Motion to approve annual CF-1's for tax abatement as presented, with the exception of the two from Gecom, made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Vietta McKenzie. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Motion to approve CF-1's for Gecom pending their payment of the filing fee and returning their update form before the next Council meeting made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Vietta McKenzie. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Allison Beck, Main Street Greensburg Executive Director, was present to share Main Street's Annual Report. Among other accomplishments, the 2023 Farmer's Market season set a record for the most vendors during a season. Beck announced upcoming events and projects that have already happened in 2024.

Zach Wirrig, Director of Public Projects, presented Ordinance 2024-11 for amendment to Parking Chapter. This ordinance will raise the current parking fee from \$10 to \$25. It also updates the language to clearly state that you cannot park where there are signs that state there is no parking. Motion to approve Ordinance 2024-11 on first reading made by Jamie Cain, seconded by Kevin Fleetwood. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Wirrig also presented Ordinance 2024-12 for Parking Restrictions. There are several streets in two different neighborhoods that have narrow streets. Currently, people are parking on both sides of the street making it difficult for public safety vehicles to navigate through and, at times, blocking mailboxes and fire hydrants. This ordinance will make "no parking" zones on one side of these streets, allowing more room for vehicles to get through. Motion to approve Ordinance 2024-12 on first reading made by Vietta McKenzie, seconded by Mark Carman. Voice vote, all ayes no nays. Motion passes.

Street Commissioner Mark Klosterkemper gave an update on heavy trash week. This time around our volume increased by about 60,000 pounds from last heavy trash week. Overall, the rules and parameters implemented made a difference in the overall time spent by the Street Department team.

Council members gave updates on their respective boards and commissions.

Mark Carman publicly noted the passing of Merrill Smith and commented on the impact Mr. Smith had on this community through his charitable work.
