# City of Greensburg Redevelopment Commission Regular Meeting Thursday, June 17, 2021 6:30 p.m. City Hall 315 S. Ireland

President Dr. David Weigel called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Roll Call - Board members present were: Dr. David Weigel, Jamie Humpert, Ken Dornich, Darrell Poling and Darren Burkhart. City Attorney Chris Stephen and City Engineer Ron May were also present. Ex-officio member Mark Bower and Mayor Josh Marsh were absent.

**Minutes** – Dr. Weigel presented the May 20, 2021 minutes for approval. They were approved as presented.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

## City Engineer - Ron May

- 1. Veterans Way Phase II Update The work on the project is going well in spite of losing almost a week of work due to rain. The chemical modifications of the subgrade are complete and the contractor has applied the first course of asphalt. All of the curb is constructed as well, except for areas near State Road 3 where traffic is still using the old pavement. Ron encouraged the board to visit the site to view the progress.
- 2. Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan They are currently working behind the scenes on The Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan. The schedule for the study review committee meeting #2 will take place after the stakeholders' list is finalized and will most likely be held in July. They are continuing with the existing conditions analysis and are processing the results from the sidewalk and pathway condition data collection. They are identifying the stakeholders that they want to interview and are continuing with the condition analysis and processing the results of the data. They plan to hold the first public meeting in July.
- **3. Veterans Way Residential Project** Darren Burkhart reported that there hasn't been much progress with the negotiations with the developer.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

**Approval of Claims -** Dr. Weigel noted that there is an error on the summary report. The figure for American StructurePoint – Construction Engineering was shown as \$37,477.28 and should be listed as \$37,447.28.
